
Question No.	Vendor Question	City Response
1	What are the required licenses and certifications for this bid (C7, C10, C33 or B)?	The vendor is responsible for obtaining required licenses and/or certifications needed to complete the project according to State requirements.
2	Will there be any existing AV system to be reused?	No.
3	Will the Audio system totally be removed?	Yes.
4	Does the removal of audio systems within the scope of the contractor?	Yes.
5	Is there a more updated and clearer floor plan of the council chambers?	No. Vendor is welcome to schedule an appointment to take photos.
6	If there's something to be reused) Is the existing audio amps/processor located on the wall mounted rack shown on one of your shared photos?	Nothing to be reused.
7	Where will the new Racks for the new system be installed?	The City will look for recommendations from the vendor.
8	Could you please specify the desired length of maintenance and support services you expect for the products and services?	Vendors should provide a warranty / guarantee that is included with the scope of work with the Proposal. In addition, the vendors may propose an as-needed maintenance schedule with associated costs. Both may be distinguishing factors of scoring and final selection.
9	What kind of services you want for maintenance and support?	All necessary services required to ensure the system is operational at all times.
10	Will there be any schematic diagrams for the new system?	A schematic diagram recommended, especially if some of the improvements may require a Building Permit. Vendor will be responsible for drafting and providing a copy of the schematic diagram to the City.
11	What will be the budget?	No preset budget is available. The reason the City has not moved forward with an upgrade project to date is a lack of funding. The City is looking for the most competitive, cost-effective proposal.
12	What is the payment term and conditions?	Payment can be negotiated based upon completion of milestone tasks.
13	What will be the target project start and accomplishment date?	Preferably start in July 2024 and complete the project as soon as possible.
14	We will only touch the audio system, Is it correct? We assume there will be a source/audio feed from your existing video system going into the new audio system?	The City's existing video system is the Zoom platform. We need an option for the "new audio system" to source/audio feed to the existing video, which is currently the DTEN monitor (which hosts the ZOOM platform).



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15	May we know the new upgrades/equipment list done last December 2023?	Upgrades were made in December, 2013: New speakers in the Council Chambers (8), Handheld pro microphone system (3) and Projector upgrade (1).
16	Was the shown wall mounted Rack the only audio related system in the room? If there are any vital component, please share it with us.	No, all audio components/related systems are within the Council Chambers.
17	How do you record the audio using the PC? How is it connected and to what device?	The City utilizes a program called <i>For The Record</i> (proprietary/licensed software) which is installed on a laptop → converter is connected to the laptop → audio feed is connected to the converter which then captures the audio of the meeting through the software.
18	Do you want us to replace the Speaker system?	Yes.
19	Can you provide the model number and brand that is shown in this picture: 	Crestron DM-TX-201-C DM Computer Center HDMI HDBT
20	During our meeting, we discussed the best micing method is assigning a microphone to each staff member. Will the City require one microphone per seat at the staff table? In total (6) wireless gooseneck microphones. Please confirm.	The City will not require one microphone per seat, but each vendor can propose on what they think would be the most cost-effective way to achieve our stated goals. Vendors can also provide one cost option for one microphone per table to be shared, and one for a total of 6 wireless microphones.
21	We also discussed implementing a separate camera system instead of the D-Ten system. The camera system and the audio system will interface to a City furnished Zoom or MS Teams PC for conferencing purposes. Can you confirm?	The City is currently satisfied with the DTEN system as we are currently not live broadcasting, however, we do need to be able to run Zoom and provide an audio feed to the DTEN/Zoom. If there is a camera system that will support Zoom and is cost-effective for limited, non-broadcasting use, the vendor can choose to propose that solution. Otherwise, vendors can propose assuming continued use of the D-Ten.
22	Would you kindly provide the model number of the projector?	Epson PowerLite Pro G6450WU Projector
23	Does the project require a bid bond submitted with the bid?	Yes.



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24	Upon award, will the City require a performance bond?	Yes.
25	Will this project be subject to Prevailing Wage rates?	Yes.
