## Mid-Winter Snow Report

The 24th of January is typically the middle of winter and a good time to see how the snow season is going. At Star Valley Ranch we will use the observation taken that has a complete record for the past 5 years. The site is located on Vista Drive near the National Forest boundary at 6400 feet in elevation.

Following are the observations on January 24 for the past 5 years at Star Valley Ranch. The water year begins on Oct. 1st.

Year	Snow Depth(in)	Season Snow Total(in)	Precipitation Total(in)
2021	22	83	6.49
2020	25	121	8.49
2019	29	106	9.87
2018	15	89	9.62
2017	40	155	16.40

The current year appears to be lower than normal with only about half the amount that was observed in 2017

## Snowmobiles in the Town of Star Valley Ranch

The Lincoln County Sheriff's Office would like to remind Star Valley Ranch citizens and visitors about the use of snowmobiles within town limits.

- The crossing of private property or riding in undesignated areas, such as the golf course greens, is prohibited.
- When crossing roadways cross at a ninety-degree angle, yielding to oncoming traffic.
- Please remember to use protective gear including helmets for your safety.
- Use common sense, good judgment, and be respectful of others' and their property.
- Minors are prohibited from operating any off-road recreational vehicle upon any public streets.
- Off-road recreational vehicles are prohibited upon public streets, unless the person has valid registration, insurance and possess a valid driver's license.
- Any person who is under the age of 18 must wear a protective helmet.
- All traffic laws apply including speed limitations, stop signs and yielding to pedestrians.

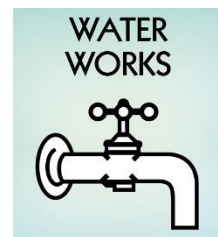


Following the laws and guidelines will make for a safe and uneventful winter riding season for you, your family and your neighbors.

## Water Project 2022

The Town of Star Valley Ranch will conduct a public meeting on Thursday, February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 6:00 pm at the Star Valley Ranch Town Hall. The purpose of the meeting is to allow citizens to review and comment on the Water Improvement Project – 2022 which will replace 14,000 lineal feet of PVC water pipeline that is undersized and failing due to faulty original construction and aging materials.



The Town of Star Valley Ranch intends to use funds from the Office of State Lands and Investments through the Wyoming Drinking Water State Revolving Loan Funds and the Mineral Royalty Grants to complete the project. The town will present the preliminary design of the proposed project and discuss the estimated cost of the improvements during the meeting.

# Arbor Day 2021

The Town of Star Valley Ranch will be celebrating our 11<sup>th</sup> annual Arbor Day on Saturday, June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The location of this year event will be announced a little later in the spring. The Town of Star Valley Ranch will also be recognized as a Tree City for our 10<sup>th</sup> consecutive year!

The Town of Star Valley Ranch has established a fund for the purchase of trees and supplies for the 2021 Arbor Day and other natural resources work. Donations can be dropped off or mailed to the Town Clerk, Kristin Gray, at Town Hall. The Natural Resource Board will add the names to our recognition plaque which is displayed at Town Hall. The minimum donation for displaying the names of donors or remembrances is \$50. Donations received after May 12<sup>th</sup> will be recorded on the plaque in 2022.
