

## Voting Sites Election Activity Buffer Zones

Per NC General Statute 163A-1134, a buffer zone is set for election-related activity (distributing campaign literature, placing campaign signage, etc.) for each polling place at not more than 50 feet and not less than 25 feet. Such election-related activity must take place outside the buffer zone.

The following list sets the number of feet from the voting entrance for each Election Day precinct:
