



Progress on CHIPs

During 2020 Stokes County adopted results based accountability. The CHA Coordinator attended two trainings: the DPH mini-series in summer of 2020 and later the three day AHEC RBA Training in May of 2021. Stokes County requested and received a waiver to submit a 2021 CHA due to the pandemic and therefore is providing this additional SOTCH report.

- Adopting Results-Based Accountability
- Transitioning from paper based to web based documents.
- Completing a 2020 SOTCH in Clear Impact Scorecard.

Covid-19's had a significant impact on the CHA-CHIP-SOTCH process and the ability to work with partners and implement planned programs.

- Substance Abuse was one of three priorities identified in the 2016 CHA. Our coalition was able to inform the community about the availability of medication lock boxes, medication disposal kits, and the four locations in Stokes County for medication drop offs. We were not able to do medication take back events. The Stokes Citizens for a Safe and Healthy Community met monthly, virtually, throughout 2020.
- The Chronic Disease Priority from 2016 focused on Diabetes and High Blood Pressure. During 2020, Stokes County Health Department and its partners were not able to have community screenings or market these services. SCHD did continue to provide prevention messages through social media: Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter!
- Cardinal Mental Health was able to provide several Mental First Aid Trainings during 2020. The Triple P Coordinator for Stokes County provided support for parents and families dealing with behavioral concern with young children.

Morbidity and Mortality Changes Since Last CHA

**July 1, 2021 COVID-19 Update**

Significant morbidity and mortality changes since the last 2016 CHA centered on COVID-19 novel virus infection.

- Vaccine Doses Given: 9,941
- Current Isolation Orders: 10
- Current Hospitalized: 2
- Recovered Cases: 4,283
- Total lab confirmed positive cases: 4,379
- Deaths: 84

Emerging Issues Since Last CHA

In Stokes County, COVID-19 forced schools, child care, public venues, restaurants, and churches to close and move to virtual/limited contact services. Stokes County enforced a mask mandate from April 2020 - Spring of 2021.

New/Paused/Discontinued Initiatives Since Last CHA

Clinical services in the local health department were limited early in 2020, but services related to communicable diseases, family planning continued with modifications.
