

On 6/21/2022 at approximately 9:52pm, the Stokes County Sheriff's Office Special Investigation Division, along with the assistance of the Surry County Sheriff's Office Narcotics Division, conducted a traffic stop on Hwy 65 W near Baux Mountain Rd while working interdiction. The vehicle, a 2006 Acura, was owned and operated by William Adkins Mitchell from Winston Salem. Mitchell was found to be in possession of 120 grams of methamphetamine, 58 grams of marijuana, 2.6 grams of fentanyl, 3.3 grams of cocaine and \$1255.00 in cash, along with drug paraphernalia. Sheriff Joey Lemons said, "As you can see, this was not a small amount for personal use. This was a trafficking amount of dangerous narcotics, meant and packaged for sale. I'm proud of our detectives for getting this poison off of the street".
