The Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Health Benefits hereby provides notice of its intent to amend the Physician Services Section, Attachment 4.19-B, Section 5, Page 2 of the Medicaid State Plan. North Carolina Session Law 2020-88, Section 13 identified a payment limit to eligible medical professionals of UNC Health Care and ECU Health expressed as a dollar cap. This cap is in aggregate and across both Fee-for-Service (FFS) and Managed Care delivery systems. This State Plan Amendment is an annual adjustment to reflect the component of the payment limit cap applicable to the Fee-for-Service activity for the State Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2023.
