ORDER

CLOSING SR#1506 – RAYMOND JESSUP ROAD

The Stokes County Board of County Commissioners, after notice and public hearing pursuant to N.C.G.S. 153A-241, makes the following findings and conclusions:

1. The State of North Carolina abandoned the road outlined in red on the attached map of SR#1506 – Raymond Jessup Road and will not maintain that entire road;
2. The requesting property owner is the sole property owner along the portion of the road to be closed;
3. Closing the public road is not contrary to the public interest and no individual owning property in the vicinity of the road would be deprived of reasonable means of ingress and egress to this property;
4. The Board of County Commissioners concludes that closing of the entire road pursuant to N.C.G.S. 153A-241 is in the best interests of the sole property owner and the citizens of the County of Stokes.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Stokes that since the State will not maintain the abandoned SR#1506 – Raymond Jessup Road, the abandoned SR#1506 – Raymond Jessup Road be closed pursuant to N.C.G.S. 153A-241.

Proposed CenterPoint Human Services Performance Agreement – Fiscal Year 2009-10
Proposed YMCA Recreation Contract – Fiscal Year 2009-10

County Manager Bryan Steen submitted the following proposed CenterPoint Human Services Performance Agreement and the proposed YMCA Recreation Contract for Fiscal Year 2009-10, with a request for action by the Board of Commissioners:

2009 – 2010 Performance Agreement
Between
Stokes County
And
CenterPoint Human Services

This is an agreement between Stokes County (County) and CenterPoint Human Services (CenterPoint). The purpose of the agreement is to ensure that County funds are used during the fiscal year 2009 – 2010 in accordance with the priorities expressed in the State certified local business plan and consistent with the needs of County citizens as described in this agreement. This agreement shall also serve as a performance contract between the County and CenterPoint. As such, the agreement provides not only responsibilities of the parties, but also specific performance requirements, monitoring and reporting requirements, provisions for corrective actions and sanctions regarding those requirements.

Nature and Term of Agreement

The agreement will be effective July 1, 2009 and will remain in effect through June 30, 2010. If a new agreement has not been reached between the parties by July 1, 2010, the FY 2009-2010 agreement will remain in force, unless it has been terminated in accordance with the provisions of this agreement.

The terms of this agreement will cover all resources provided by the County during the fiscal year. CenterPoint’s performance will extend to all services that it provides or manages within the County on behalf of County residents.

County Responsibilities

The County agrees to:

1. Assure the appointment of County residents to serve on the area authority board in accordance with the North Carolina General Statutes and the joint resolution of Stokes, Davie and Forsyth Counties that established CenterPoint Human Services as a multi-county area authority as expanded on July 1, 2009 with the addition of Rockingham County with responsibility to serve Stokes County.
2. Review and approve amendments to the certified Local Business Plan and subsequent Local Business Plan(s).
3. Allocate available funds to CenterPoint to support its activities as the Local Management Entity in accordance with the certified Local Business Plan.
4. Allocate available funds to CenterPoint to support mental health, developmental disabilities and substance abuse services for County residents in accordance with service priorities established by the Division of MH/DD/SA Services of the NC Dept. of Health & Human Services, CenterPoint Board of Directors and the Board of Commissioners.
5. Provide County facilities and support services as negotiated with CenterPoint.
6. Negotiate an annual performance agreement with CenterPoint to establish funding levels and clear expectations for the quality and quantity of services covered by this agreement.
7. Receive, review and approve reports on the performance of CenterPoint as the manager and/or provider of services as well as any plans for corrective action.
8. Establish a plan for quarterly consultation between the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners, Sheriff, County Manager and CenterPoint’s CEO and/or a Deputy Area Director regarding this agreement and

emerging community issues. Meetings will occur on the second Tuesdays of February, May, August and November at 2:00 PM in the County Manager's office.

9. Require biannual presentations by CenterPoint's CEO, Sheriff and County Manager to the Board of Commissioners in March and September.

CenterPoint Responsibilities

CenterPoint agrees to:

1. Carry out the responsibilities of a multi-county Local Management Entity as required by North Carolina General Statutes and the joint resolution of Stokes, Davie and Forsyth Counties that established CenterPoint Human Services as the area authority as expanded on July 1, 2009 with the addition of Rockingham County with responsibility to serve Stokes County.
2. Serve as the Local Management Entity for the County in accordance with the certified Local Business Plan and make regular quarterly reports to the County on the implementation of the Plan including the re-organization and contracting of services.
3. Conduct community planning and submit proposed amendments of the certified Local Business Plan to the Board of Commissioners for approval.
4. Develop and present a complete annual budget to support its activities as a Local Management Entity and make requests for funding to the County following prescribed guidelines.
5. Develop and present a complete annual budget to support mental health, developmental disabilities and substance abuse services for County residents in accordance with service priorities established by the Board of Directors and make requests for funding to the County following prescribed guidelines.
6. Negotiate an annual performance agreement with the County to establish funding levels and clear expectations for the quality and quantity of services covered by this agreement.
7. Submit regular reports on its performance as the manager and/or provider of services including plans of correction for any area in which its performance does not meet the established expectations.
8. Assure that the CEO and/or a Deputy Area Director meets regularly with County officials as required under County responsibilities #8 to review CenterPoint's performance under this agreement and to discuss emerging community issues.
9. Make biannual presentations to the Board of Commissioners in March and September.

Specific Performance Expectations

In addition to the general responsibilities outlined above, CenterPoint agrees to the following specific performance expectations:

1. Outpatient services - Maintain the current continuum of services for mental health, developmental disabilities and substance abuse services including the operation of clinics in both Danbury and King to the maximum extent possible within financial constraints.
2. Stokes Opportunity Center - Maintain the current level of vocational services for individuals with mental illness and/or developmental disabilities to the maximum extent possible within financial constraints; pursue other funding sources for these services; and, explore alternatives that maintain current levels of service at less cost.
3. After Hours & Hospital follow-up - require quarterly reports from provider(s) that document(s) appropriate follow-up with all clients/families who become involved in an afterhours service or hospitalization.
4. Provide annual reports to the County that describes the following.
 - a. The providers serving Stokes County residents during the period, the services provided, and the location(s) of the provision of such services;
 - b. The number and demographics of different Stokes County Residents served during the period;
 - c. The volume and type of services provided to these residents;
 - d. Data analysis tracking the effectiveness of services provided including complaints and outcomes;
 - e. Clients' level of satisfaction with services; and
 - f. Families' level of satisfaction with services.
5. Sheriff's Department Relationship –
 - a. Maintain the 1st Opinion Waiver Pilot Program at site(s) specified by the County Manager, CenterPoint, and the provider to ensure that behavioral health staff conduct assessments of Stokes County residents who the Sheriff's Department believes exhibits significant mental health and/or substance abuse issues in less than two (2) hours of arrival in the custody of the Stokes County Sheriff's Department at the designated site. Services are to be rendered at the jail to the maximum extent possible.
 - b. Contract with providers including Forsyth Medical Center to provide timely response within four (4) hours of the arrival of a Stokes County resident exhibiting significant mental health and/or substance abuse issues in the custody of the Stokes County Sheriff's Department.
 - c. Monitoring activities:
 - Sheriff's Department will track all transports for psychiatric emergencies including original destination (1st Opinion), disposition and time involved;
 - Sheriff's Department will report each instance when the time to complete the 1st Opinion exceeds four (4) hours;
 - Sheriff's Department will report every case that exceeds eight (8) hours;
 - CenterPoint will review each case reported by the Sheriff's Department and will meet with the Sheriff's Department on any such case at the Sheriff's request;
 - CenterPoint will review any case and meet with the Sheriff's Department on any case that either party concludes has extenuating circumstances, regardless of the time involved.

- CenterPoint and the Sheriff's Department and other County officials will meet at least four times a year as required in County Responsibilities #8 to establish baseline data, determine outcome goals and to review the overall effort to meet these outcomes.
6. Financial Goals - Pursue all reasonable means to increase revenues from non-county budget sources to assist the County in providing services responsive to the behavioral health needs of Stokes County residents.

Corrective Actions / Sanctions for Non-Performance

It is in the best interest of the citizens of Stokes County, and especially of those receiving services from CenterPoint or its contractors, that every effort be made to achieve the levels of performance required in this agreement. If CenterPoint does not meet the performance expectations outlined in this agreement, it will recommend a Plan of Correction to the County Manager. The Plan of Correction will include the name of the individual who is responsible to act, the activity or task to be undertaken, the outcome expected and the date by which the action should be completed. The CEO will make progress reports to the County Manager and the Board of Commissioners as required.

If corrective action does not result in an improvement in CenterPoint's performance to the level expected, the County may withhold payment for all or any portion of the payments remaining under this agreement. Prior to withholding payment for unacceptable performance, the County will notify CenterPoint's Board of Directors, in writing, of its intended action including an explanation. If the County withholds funding and CenterPoint's performance subsequently improves to the expected level, the County may reinstate all or any part of the withheld payments.

Amendments

This agreement may be amended by mutual consent of the County and CenterPoint.

Termination

This agreement may be terminated, in whole or in part, by mutual consent of the County and CenterPoint. Either the County or CenterPoint may terminate this agreement for cause with 90 days notice to the other. In the event of termination of a part of this agreement, the County and CenterPoint agree to continue all the activities and responsibilities not terminated. In the event of termination of this agreement prior to its expiration date, the County will pay CenterPoint for any services provided up to the date of termination.

County of Stokes & Stokes Family YMCA

RECREATION CONTRACT

This contract for Recreation Services (herein the "Contract") is made by and between the Stokes Family YMCA herein known at the "YMCA", and the County of Stokes, herein know as the "County". For and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

Responsibilities of the YMCA

The YMCA agrees to provide the following minimum services:

1. The YMCA shall administer and coordinate all current recreation and wellness programming to include Stokes County Youth Basketball & Cheerleading, Summer Day Camp, Stokes County Easter Egg Hunt, other seasonal family special events, Moratock Triathlon, Fitness Center operation and wellness services.
2. A Summer Youth Program shall be provided to the youth of Stokes County. This program shall be for the length of time specified each year in the Annual Budget (as herein defined). This program shall utilize school sites as well as YMCA and County facilities.
3. The YMCA shall provide recreation, wellness and social programs at a County facility, at the County's sole expense except for long distance telephone calls, in Danbury, North Carolina. The YMCA shall maintain regular office hours and Fitness Center hours of operation in said facility.
4. Stokes County Youth Basketball & Cheerleading League shall be provided to the youth of Stokes County. The program shall last a minimum of seven weeks.
5. The YMCA shall host the annual Moratock Triathlon.
6. New Programs shall be offered based on need and availability, such as additional summer camps, sports, recreation and wellness programs and social events.
7. The YMCA shall assume all liability insurance coverage for all YMCA staff and program offerings.
8. The YMCA shall administer the scheduling of shelter usage and special events to be held at Moratock Park, located in Danbury, North Carolina.
9. The YMCA shall collect all fees as set by the Stokes County Board of Commissioners for use of Moratock Park facilities and remit those funds back to the County as requested by the County.
10. The YMCA shall retain all revenues generated by program offerings, except those fees generated from Moratock Park shelter usage.
11. The YMCA shall provide a Stokes County Recreation Department Committee under the authorization of the Stokes Family YMCA volunteer Board of Management. The Committee shall consist of Stokes Family YMCA

volunteers, Stokes County citizens and a designated representative of the Stokes County Board of Commissioners.

Responsibilities of the County of Stokes

The County of Stokes agrees to the following responsibilities:

1. The County shall maintain ownership of Moratock Park located in Danbury, North Carolina. Further, the County shall provide maintenance and repair services for Moratock Park up to and including grounds maintenance, facility maintenance, insurance and utility costs.
2. The County shall provide a facility to serve as a Program Center to the YMCA in Danbury, North Carolina at the County's sole expense except for long distance telephone calls. The County shall maintain ownership of said facility and shall provide maintenance and repair services up to and including road maintenance, grounds maintenance, facility maintenance, insurance and utility costs.
4. The County shall provide, at its sole cost and expense, the YMCA staff in Stokes County with one (1) vehicle for travel solely within Stokes County in maintaining programs based in Stokes County and offered to Stokes County citizens.
5. The County shall allow the YMCA staff to purchase fuel at the Stokes County fueling facilities for use in the vehicle provided by the County.

Cost

The County hereby agrees to pay to the YMCA an amount equal to one hundred seventeen thousand and four hundred and eighty-four dollars (\$117,484) for the contract year. This contract sum shall be paid in two (2) equal installments with the first payment due on July 15th and the second due on January 15th of the contract term.

Term

The term of this contract shall be for a period of one year. This contract may be extended for additional periods upon the expressed written consent of both parties.

Contract Termination

Either party wishing to terminate this contract may do so upon one-hundred and eighty days written notice to the other party.

Hold Harmless Provision

The YMCA hereby agrees to indemnify and hold the County harmless from all liability arising out of the provision of recreational programs and services as set forth herein.

The County agrees to indemnify and hold the YMCA harmless from all liability arising out of the provision of County maintenance and facilities.

Contract Date and Signatures

This contract for services shall commence as of July 1, 2009 and terminate on June 30, 2010. Contract term extensions are provided in the section of this contract titled "Term".

GENERAL GOVERNMENT – GOVERNING BODY – INFORMATION AGENDA

Update – Manager and Board of Commissioners

County Manager Bryan Steen noted the following:

- Sheriff's Department has been awarded a \$62,918 Department of Justice Grant, which requires no county match. The Department will be using the grant funding for the purchase of equipment.
- With recent outbreak of the Swine Flu, Health Director Josh Swift is planning on scheduling several flu clinics this fall at fire departments and community centers around the county to make flu vaccinations more readily available to the citizens of Stokes County

- Would like to discuss scheduling a Groundbreaking Ceremony for the new EMS facility in the Pinnacle area

Zero or Low Interest School Bonds – Stokes County Schools

Operations Director David Burge discussed the following information regarding Zero or Low Interest School Bonds: (School System was notified on June 25, 2009 about the bonds)

Qualified School Construction Bonds (QSCB)

- QSCBs are new bonds established as part of the American Recovery Reinvestment Act of 2009
- Bond proceeds are for the specific use of construction (both new and additions), rehabilitation or repair of a public school, or land acquisition for such a facility
- Funds may not be used for stadiums or other facilities primarily used for athletic contests or exhibitions or other events for which admission is charged to the general public
- Maximum term of indebtedness is about 12 years under current market conditions which are subject to change, is set by the US Treasury so that local government's obligation to repay in present value terms will be 50 percent of the borrowed amount
- Zero or low interest
- QSCBs may be issued by local governments, which will then be responsible for repaying the principal amount
- QSCBs must be issued by December 31, 2009 and the proceeds spent within 3 years of issue date
- Board of Education must adopt a Resolution certifying the eligibility of the proposed QSCB project with a proposed spending plan and project schedule
- Stokes County has been allotted \$1,568,543.75, amount could be more if other counties chose not to participate in the program
- Applications must be post marked no later than July 31, 2009

Qualified Zone Academy Bonds (QZAB)

- QZABS is a tax code provision created under the Taxpayer Relief Act of 1997 and designed to assist eligible local education agencies and schools to establish qualified zone academies in partnership with local businesses (included in the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009)
- School must have commitment from private business equal to at least 10 percent of the interest free capital provided under the program
- QZABs may used to rehabilitate or repair the public school facility in which a qualified zone academy (public school or academic program) is located
- Maximum term of indebtedness is about 12 years under current market conditions which are subject to change, is set by the US Treasury so that the local government's obligation to repay in present value terms will be 50 percent of the borrowed amount
- 10% local community match which can be an in-kind match
- Interest free
- Application must be post marked no later than July 31, 2009
- County can qualify for up to \$4 million, with \$500,000 being the minimum amount awarded
- QZAB Program is competitive
- Would like to use the QZAB for Southeastern Project
- Possibly work with Duke Power for the in-kind match
- County has never used the QZAB Program, which could be an advantage when funding is awarded

Director Burge requested direction from the Board regarding whether to proceed with the application process for the QSCB and QZAB Programs. Director Burge reiterated that the application must include the proposed project with estimated project costs.

Board of Education Chairperson Bill Hart reiterated the use of QZABs for part of the Southeastern Project which the total project is estimated at approximately \$9.2 million (construction

of B Building and some of the small renovations would be approximately \$5.5 million).

The Board discussed both bond programs, the need to consult the financial advisor before committing any amount, 10% community match for the QZAB program, applying for the maximum amount that could be awarded to the County, and giving direction to the School Board to proceed with the bond applications.

Commissioner Lankford expressed concerns with giving the School Board direction to proceed with the application before having the County's financial advisor rework the County's current financial model.

Vice Chairman Walker requested additional information regarding the County's obligation if awarded a specific amount.

Director Burge noted that he would need to research that information and get back to the Board.

Chairman Inman noted the County could request the financial advisor insert each bond amount separately (\$4m and \$1.5m) into the County's financial model along with a combined amount of \$5.5.

Chairman Inman directed Director Burge to obtain the information regarding the County's obligation if awarded a specific amount and directed Manager Steen to request the financial information from the County's financial advisor.

Chairman Inman requested direction from each board member as to whether to instruct the Board of Education to proceed with the bond applications.

- Commissioner Carroll directed the Board of Education to proceed with both applications
- Commissioner Smith directed the Board of Education to proceed with bond applications
- Vice Chairman Walker directed the Board of Education to proceed with bond applications
- Chairman Inman directed the Board of Education to proceed with bond applications
- Commissioner Lankford passed

Proposed Fiscal Year 2009-10 Rural Operating Assistance Program-Transportation Funding

YVEDDI Transportation Coordinator Charlie Walker presented the following information regarding the proposed Fiscal Year 2009-10 Rural Operating Assistance Program:

- Program is same as last year other than funding amounts
- **EDTAP** funds will be used to provide transportation services for elderly and disabled individuals when other funding sources are not available
- **Employment Transportation Assistance** (Administered by DSS in Stokes) can only be sub-allocated to the Department of Social Services, Workforce Development Programs and/or Community Transportation System in the County (helps clients get back into the work force)

- **Rural General Public Funds** are intended to provide transportation services for individuals who are not human services agency clients (individuals who need transportation at a reduced rate – individuals pay \$.60 a mile)
- Flow through funding
- Statistical Information
 - July 1, 2008-May 31, 2009 - provided 2,200 trips with ETAP Funding
 - July 1, 2008-May 31, 2009 - provided 4,696 trips with RGP Funding
 - July 1, 2008-May 31, 2009 – provided 6,896 total trips
 - Estimate 2,600 trips with ETAP Funding by the end of 08/09 fiscal year
 - Estimate 5,000 trips with RGP Funding by the end of 08/09 fiscal year
- Prices same as last year
- Request approval to submit a Resolution at the July 27th meeting for YVEDDI to operate the Fiscal Year 2009-10 Rural Operating Assistance Program

The Board discussed the Rural Operating Assistance Program with Mr. Walker.

Chairman Inman, with full consent of the Board, directed Mr. Walker to provide the Clerk with a proposed Resolution for consideration at the July 27th meeting.

Proposed Rental Agreement – YVEDDI Head Start

County Manager Bryan Steen presented the following information regarding a proposed rental agreement with YVEDDI Head Start:

- YVEDDI Head Start has requested to lease county space located at 1070 Hospice Drive in Danbury (modular unit beside YMCA) for a Head Start Classroom (approximately 1380 sq ft) along with a fenced playground area adjoining the building and modular unit on the south west side (approximately 3,000 sq ft) as well as a smaller fenced playground on the South end of the modular unit
- Request also to place a storage building adjacent to the modular unit
- Term of lease shall be for a period of 4 years commencing on August 1, 2009 and ending on July 31, 2013
- YVEDDI has agreed to make the following improvements to the facility at no cost to the county: replace existing floor with new tile=\$3700, paint interior of the facility=\$1500, convert current kitchen door to a half door, expand the current playground up to approximately 3,000 sq. ft. and install a pass through window in the kitchen wall=\$300.00
- YVEDDI will pay rental in advance in the amount of \$400.00 per month with the fee to be renegotiated on the anniversary date with a maximum increase of four percent each anniversary
- Space will be used only for operation related to a Head Start Program
- All utilities (except water) will be paid by YVEDDI Head Start
- Proposed lease has been reviewed and approved by County Attorney Powell
- Request to move to today's Action Agenda

YVEDDI Head Start Assistant Director Nick Hawks noted the following:

- Head Start previously located at Nancy Reynolds Elementary School
- Having to move due to renovation project
- Would like a permanent location
- Already have a partnership with Stokes Family YMCA who can use the playground when not in use by the Head Start Program
- Would like to open when school starts on August 25th
- Need approval as soon as possible in order to start renovations and get accreditation approved by the State
- Federally funded program
- Will have 18 students in the Danbury location
- Rental with similar space at Sandy Ridge Elementary School is \$175 per month

The Board discussed the proposed lease with Director Hawks and Manager Steen.

LEASE

STOKES COUNTY

THIS LEASE, made and entered into this **13th** day of **July, 2009**, by and between **THE COUNTY OF STOKES**, (hereinafter referred to as the "Landlord"); and Yadkin Valley Economic Development District, Inc., (hereinafter referred to as "Tenant").

WITNESSETH:

That for and consideration of the rental hereinafter reserved and the covenants and agreements herein contained, Landlord has agreed to Lease and does hereby demise and Lease unto Tenant, and Tenant has agreed to take and Lease and does hereby Lease from Landlord, the following described premises:

Modular Building with approximately 1,380 sq. ft. of space attached to the permanent building located at 1070 Hospice Drive, Danbury, NC.

A fenced playground area adjoining the building and modular structure on the South West side of the facility having approximately 3,000 sq. feet as well as a smaller fenced playground on the South end of the modular structure.

1. TERM OF LEASE

The term of this Lease shall be for a period of 4 years, commencing at 12:01 A.M. on the 01 day of August, 2009 and ending at 11:59 P.M. on the 31 day of July, 2013, both dates inclusive.

2. RENTAL:

The Tenant is willing to make the following improvements to the desired facility at their sole cost and expense as estimated: replace existing floor with new tile, \$3,700.00; paint interior of facility, \$1,500.00; convert current kitchen door to a half door; expand the current play ground up to approximately 3,000 sq. ft. and install a pass through window in the kitchen wall, \$300.00. In consideration of the proposed improvements, the Tenant shall pay rental in advance in the amount of \$400.00 per month to the Landlord on the first day of each month during the first year of the Lease term and the fee to be renegotiated on the anniversary date with a maximum increase of four percent each anniversary.

3. USE OF PREMISES:

The Leased premises shall be used only for operation related to a "Head Start " Program. Tenant shall comply with all rules, laws, ordinances and regulations of federal, state, county, municipal and other governmental authorities respecting the use, maintenance and operation of the Leased premises, and will make no unlawful use thereof. Tenant is also authorized to place a 10' x 12' outbuilding on the property near the S.W. Playground for storage of equipment and non-hazardous materials.

4. PARKING

Tenant shall have access to parking spaces adjacent demised premises.

5. ACCEPTANCE OF PREMISES:

Tenant has inspected the premises and accepts same in their present working condition, with absolutely no obligation upon the Landlord to make any additional repairs or improvements. Additionally, Tenant accepts and may use existing appliances for there intended purpose (stove, dishwasher and refrigerator), but Tenant must repair or replace them at no cost to Landlord.

6. UTILITIES:

During the term of this Lease, Tenant shall pay all cost related to telephone, electricity and internet connection.

7. TAXES:

If applicable, Tenant shall pay when due all taxes imposed or assessed upon the demised premises, merchandise, inventory or other property installed or brought onto the demised premises by or for the Tenant.

8. ALTERATIONS:

Tenant may, with prior written consent of Landlord, and at its sole cost and expense, from time to time during the term of this Lease, make such alterations, additions or changes, in and to the Leased premises as it finds necessary or desirable and convenient for its purposes. All changes, alterations and additions shall be left in place at the termination of this Lease and shall become the sole property of Landlord.

9. ASSIGNMENT AND SUBLETTING:

This Lease shall not be transferred or assigned, nor the demised premises or any part thereof sublet by the Tenant except with the written consent of the Landlord.

10. INSURANCE:

Tenant agrees that he will at all times during the term hereof, at his own expense, maintain and keep in force public liability insurance in an amount of not less than \$1,000,000.00 against claims for bodily injury, death or property damage occurring in or on or about the demised premises and will also provide at his sole cost and expense, such fire and extended coverage and vandalism and malicious mischief insurance covering the contents of the demised premises as the Tenant deems advisable. The Landlord shall keep the premises and the building and improvements thereon, to wit: all of the property deemed to be real property under the terms of this Lease insured to the extent of the full replacement cost thereof against loss or damage by fire, with extended coverage. Tenant shall pay the cost of said insurance coverage.

11. DAMAGE AND DESTRUCTION:

If the leased premises be damaged or destroyed in whole or in part at any time during the term of this Lease by fire or other casualty, Landlord may at its option, terminate this Lease or restore the premises to the condition existing before the

damage or destruction, in which case rent shall be abated according to the amount of square footage available to the Tenant or use to conduct business in while the repair and/or restoration takes place.

12. CONDEMNATION:

In the event that all of the leased premises shall be taken in condemnation proceedings or by right of eminent domain, this Lease shall terminate as of the date of said taking, and all unearned rent and all other charges paid in advance shall be refunded to the Tenant and the Tenant shall surrender possession of the leased premises to Landlord. The award for such taking shall belong to the Landlord except that, in the event Tenant expends any sum of money for improvements to the leased premises, which, when completed, constitute part of the real estate, a pro rata share of the net award, based on the value of the improvements made by Tenant, shall belong to Tenant. Tenant shall also be entitled to make claim in its own name to the condemning authorities for the value of any furniture, trade fixtures, trade equipment, merchandise or personal property of any kind belonging to Tenant and not forming part of the real estate, or for the cost of moving all of the same, and any such award made directly to Tenant shall belong entirely to Tenant.

In the event that a portion of, but not all, of the leased premises shall be taken in condemnation proceedings or by exercise of any right of eminent domain and if as a result of such partial taking the ground floor area of the building on the leased premises remaining after the taking is less than fifty (50) percent of the ground floor area of said building prior to the taking, then in such event, Tenant shall have the right to terminate this Lease provided the Tenant shall have given notice to Landlord within thirty (30) days after knowledge by Tenant of such taking of Tenant's intention to cancel this Lease. Whereupon, Tenant shall be liable only for the rent up to the time of such taking or the date when Tenant shall vacate the leased premises, whichever date is later, and Tenant shall be entitled to refund of any advanced rentals paid by it for the period subsequent to the latter of such dates.

In the event that Tenant does not exercise its election to cancel this Lease, then and in that event:

1. This Lease shall continue in full force and effect as to the portion of the leased premises not taken for the balance of the term of the Lease; however, the annual rent for the unexpired term shall be reduced by that portion which the area so taken shall bear to the entire area of the demised premises immediately prior to such taking; and Tenant shall be entitled to a pro rata share of the net condemnation award, based on the value of any improvements made by Tenant and taken in the condemnation proceeding.

2. Tenant diligently shall make all necessary repairs or alterations to restore the building to a complete architectural unit.

13. REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE:

Tenant will be responsible for and pay the cost of all repairs and maintenance necessary to keep the exterior, interior, structure, and all systems of the demised premises in good order and repair. Tenant agrees to surrender the demised premises at the expiration or earlier termination of this Lease in as good or better condition as when received, excepting only deterioration caused by ordinary wear and tear and damage by fire or other casualty of the kind insured against in standard policies of fire insurance.

14. ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

Tenant warrants and agrees that the business it will conduct on the property will not involve the use or disposal of any hazardous material.

15. INDEMNIFICATION:

To the extent not otherwise covered by insurance, Tenant hereby agrees to indemnify Landlord and hold Landlord harmless from and against any and all losses, liabilities, damages, injuries, costs, expenses and claims of any kind whatsoever paid, incurred, or suffered by, or asserted against Landlord which are caused by the acts, omissions or activities of Tenant during the Tenant's use and occupancy of the leased premises.

16. QUIET ENJOYMENT:

Except as otherwise stated herein, Tenant, upon paying the rent, and subject to all of the terms and covenants of this Lease, on Tenant's part to be kept, observed, and performed, shall quietly have and enjoy the leased premises during the term of this Lease without hindrance or molestation by any person. Landlord agrees that Tenant, its successors, and assigns, shall have continuous, peaceful, uninterrupted and exclusive possession and quiet enjoyment of the entire premises during the term of this Lease. The Landlord covenants that at the time of the execution of this Lease, Landlord is in legal possession of the demised premises, has full right to lease the same for the aforesaid, and will put Tenant in actual possession of the premises hereinbefore provided.

17. DEFAULT:

Tenant fails to keep and fulfill any of the covenants and agreements herein provided and shall remain in default for a period of (thirty) 30 days after receipt of written notice thereof by Tenant, then Landlord may terminate this Lease and demand possession of the premises, without prejudice to any other remedy which Landlord may have on account of such default.

Tax Administrator Oakley presented the following request from Mr. and Mrs. Marcus Butner:

- Request Stokes County release a portion of their property located in Stokes County back to Forsyth County –Parcel 598111572397

Tax Administrator Oakley presented the following information regarding Mr. and Mrs. Butner's request:

- Mr. & Mrs. Butner own 17.04 acres of land, two houses, and other buildings that have been taxed by Stokes County since 2004
- Total current assessment on this parcel is \$608,100
- Prior to 2004, Forsyth County was taxing the Butner property, even though the majority of the parcel was located in Stokes County
- In 2004, a discovery was made by Stokes County and Forsyth County corrected the error by transferring (home and 2.4 acres) for taxation back to Stokes County
- The property was originally assigned an address by Forsyth County which was the determining factor for the school district
- Children are currently enrolled in Ronald Reagan High School in Forsyth County
- A corrected address would dictate attendance in the Stokes County School System
- Mr. & Mrs. Butner are making the request in order for the children to continue to go to school in Forsyth County, not be required to change their home address along with a business address, and alleviate the confusion in the E911 system in case of emergencies
- Stokes County has given the parcel a Stokes County address, Mr. & Mrs. Butner are currently not using the Stokes County assigned address
- Mr. & Mrs. Butner are requesting Stokes County to release a portion to Forsyth County – one acre of land, one house, home site allowance, and pool = total value \$220,200
- Mr. & Mrs. Butner's request would result in a loss in revenue of \$1,333.20 to the General Fund and a loss in revenue of \$144.43 to the King Fire District

- NCGS 105-301 states “All taxable real property that is not required by this subchapter to be appraised originally by the Department of Revenue shall be listed in the county in which it is situated”
- Mrs. Butner requested that the matter be brought before the Board of Commissioners
- NC General Statute does not allow a County to issue taxes on property that is not located in their county
- If the Board chose to approve the request and the matter was challenged, the Board of Commissioners could be held liable for the taxes on this property
- Stokes County Tax Administration has been discussing the issue with the Forsyth County
- County boundary lines are based on USGS Quad Maps, which was approved by State Legislation which indicates where county lines are located and creates uniformity, Stokes County was approved by the State several years ago
- Stokes County works with adjoining counties when issues such as this come up, the county in which the home is located issues the taxes on the property

Tax Administrator Oakley stated the Tax Department recommends denying Mr. & Mrs. Butner’s request based upon NCGS 105-301, as their dwelling is actually located in Stokes County.

Proposed Water Shortage Response Plan – Danbury Water System

Public Works Director Mark Delehant presented the following proposed Water Shortage Response Plan for the Danbury Water System:

**Stokes County Public Works
Town of Danbury, North Carolina
Water Shortage Response Plan**

July 2009

The procedures herein are written to reduce potable water demand and supplement existing drinking water supplies whenever they are in danger of being inadequate to meet customer needs.

I. Authorization

The Stokes County Manager is authorized to enact water shortage response provisions whenever the trigger conditions outlined in Section IV are met. In his or her absence, the Public Works Director will assume this role.

The following notification methods will be used to inform water system employees and customers of a water shortage declaration: employee e-mail announcements, notices at municipal buildings, notices in water bills and on the Stokes County website homepage. Required water shortage response measures will be communicated through *The Stokes News*, PSA announcements on local radio and cable stations, and on the Stokes County website. Declaration of emergency water restrictions or water rationing will be communicated to all customers by telephone through use of reverse 911.

III. Levels of Response

Five levels of water shortage response are outlined in the table below. The five levels of water shortage response are: voluntary reductions, mandatory reductions I and II, emergency reductions and water rationing. A detailed description of each response level and corresponding water reduction measures follow below.

Stage	Response	Description
1	Voluntary Reductions	Water users are encouraged to reduce their water use and improve water use efficiency; however, no penalties apply for noncompliance. Water supply conditions indicate a potential for shortage.
2	Mandatory Reductions I	Water users must comply with required water use reduction and efficiency measures; penalties apply for noncompliance. Water supply conditions are significantly lower than the seasonal norm and water shortage conditions are expected to persist.
3	Mandatory Reductions II	Same as in Stage 2
4	Emergency Reductions	Water supply conditions are substantially diminished and pose an imminent threat to human health or environmental integrity.
5	Water Rationing	Water supply conditions are substantially diminished and remaining supplies must be allocated to preserve human health and environmental integrity.

In Stage 1, Voluntary Reductions, all water users will be asked to reduce their normal water use by 5%. Customer education and outreach programs will encourage water conservation and efficiency measures including: irrigating landscapes a maximum of one inch per week; preventing water waste, runoff and watering impervious surfaces; watering

plants deeply to encourage root growth; washing only full loads in clothes and dishwashers; using spring-loaded nozzles on garden hoses; and identifying and repairing all water leaks.

In Stage 2, Mandatory Reductions I, all customers are expected to reduce their water use by 10% in comparison to their previous month's water bill. In addition to continuing to encourage all voluntary reduction actions, the following restrictions apply: irrigation is limited to a half inch per week between 8PM and 8AM; outdoor use of drinking water for washing impervious surfaces is prohibited; and all testing and training purposes requiring drinking water (e.g. fire protection) will be limited.

In Stage 3, Mandatory Reductions II, customers must continue actions from all previous stages and further reduce water use by 20% compared to their previous month's water bill. All non-essential uses of drinking water are banned and garden and landscape irrigation must be reduced to the minimum amount necessary for survival. Additionally, in Stage 3, a drought surcharge of 1.5 times the normal water rate applies.

In Stage 4, Emergency Reductions, customers must continue all actions from previous stages and further reduce their water use by 25% compared to their previous month's water bill. A ban on all use of drinking water except to protect public health and safety is implemented and drought surcharges increase to 2 times the normal water rate.

The goal of Stage 5, Water Rationing, is to provide drinking water to protect public health (i.e. residences, residential health care facilities and correctional facilities). In Stage 5, all customers are only permitted to use water at the minimum required for public health protection. Firefighting is the only allowable outdoor water use and pickup locations for distributing potable water will be announced according to Stokes County's Emergency Response Plan. Drought surcharges increase to 5 times the normal water rate.

IV. Triggers

Stage	Well Operating Conditions
1	Pumping Time >10 hrs 20% reduction in seasonal normal distance from static water level and pump intake 20% increase pumping time for same output
2	Pumping Time >12 hrs 40% reduction in distance from static water level and pump intake 40% increase pumping time for same output
3	Pumping Time >14 hrs 60% reduction in distance from static water level and pump intake 60% increase pumping time for same output
4	Pumping Time >20 hrs 80% reduction in distance from static water level and pump intake
5	Water level at pump intake elevation

V. Enforcement

The provisions of the water shortage response plan will be enforced by the County of Stokes Public Works Department and Sheriff Office personnel. Violators may be reported to the County's Public Works Department or the Public Works Director via

E-mail listed on the County's website (<http://www.co.stokes.nc.us/>). Citations are assessed according to the following schedule depending on the number of prior violations and current level of water shortage.

Drought surcharge rates are effective in Stages 3, 4 and 5.

VI. Public Comment

Customers will have multiple opportunities to comment on the provisions of the water shortage response plan. First, a draft plan will be posted on the Stokes County website. A public hearing will be scheduled with notice printed on all customer water bills to collect comments on the draft. All subsequent revisions to the draft plan will be posted at least 30 days prior to an adoption vote by the Stokes County Commissioners.

VII. Variance Protocols

Applications for water use variance requests are available from the Stokes County Public Works Office. All applications must be submitted to the Public Works Office for review by the Public Works Director or his or her designee. A decision

to approve or deny individual variance requests will be determined within two weeks of submittal after careful consideration of the following criteria: impact on water demand, expected duration, alternative source options, social and economic importance, purpose (i.e. necessary use of drinking water) and the prevention of structural damage.

VIII. Effectiveness

The effectiveness of the Stokes County Public Works, Town of Danbury water shortage response plan will be determined by comparing the stated water conservation goals with observed water use reduction data. Other factors to be considered include frequency of plan activation, any problem periods without activation, total number of violation citations, desired reductions attained and evaluation of demand reductions compared to the previous year's seasonal data.

IX. Revision

The water shortage response plan will be reviewed and revised as needed to adapt to new circumstances affecting water supply and demand, following implementation of emergency restrictions, and at a minimum of every five years, as required by the provisions of G.S. 143-355 (l). Further, a water shortage response planning work group will review procedures following each emergency or rationing stage to recommend any necessary improvements to the plan to The Stokes County Commissioners. The Stokes County Public Works Director is responsible for initiating all subsequent revisions.

Public Works Director Delehant noted the following regarding the proposed Response Plan:

- Proposed plan was discussed at the May 11th meeting
- A Public Hearing was held on May 26th – there were no public comments
- Proposed plan was sent to all water customers on June 1st requesting any comments with a deadline of June 20th
- Received no comments from water customers
- Feels the proposed plan will be adequate for Stokes County
- Proposed plan is mandated by the State, each water provider must have in a plan in the event of a drought
- Request consideration for approval at the July 27th meeting

The Board discussed the Agenda item.

Chairman Inman, with full consent of the Board, directed the Clerk to place the item on the July 27th Action Agenda.

Vacant County Job Positions

Manager Bryan Steen recommended filling the following positions:

- Patrol Deputy – vacant since 06-01-09
- Jail Administrator – will be vacant on 09-01-09
- Social Worker III – Vacant on 06-26-09
- QA Coordinator – E911 (modification of current telecommunicator position to QA as discussed during Budget Work Session)

County Manager Steen noted the current Jail Administrator will be retiring August 31st and Sheriff Mike Joyce would like to hold reviews for the position. Sheriff Joyce tries to hire within which usually causes a domino effect. Manager Steen requested direction from the Board on how to handle the successive vacancies caused by the domino effect.

Director Jan Spencer sent information to Manager Steen explaining the need to try to fill the vacant Social Worker III position. Director Spencer noted this is a very critical position with the agency currently having 70 foster children, which requires the supervisor to carry a caseload.

Manager Steen noted the E911 Director wishes to eliminate the floater telecommunicator position in order to keep the QA Coordinator position, this was discussed briefly in one of the last budget work sessions.

E911 Director Del Hall noted the following:

- After having the position for one year (funded by grant in fiscal year 2008-09) feels the QA Coordinator position is more valuable to the department than the floater telecommunicator position
- The floater telecommunicator position is very hard to fill due to the shift being 3:00 pm to 3:00 am
- Staff allocated to Communications will remain the same – no new position
- QA Coordinator grades at least 25 EMS calls per week making sure all protocols are followed, calls are logged into the system correctly, questions are answered correctly
- Issues are addressed immediately and if necessary, review training for telecommunicator is conducted
- Efficiency has increased since the creation of the QA position
- Software was approved in the 09/10 budget to monitor police and fire calls, which will mean 50 additional calls to monitor
- Job performance and efficiency have improved at least 30% percent
- Can make this request work with no additional funding
- Feels this staff arrangement will be the best option for his department and the County

Commissioner Carroll stated that the E911 Director knows the needs of the department and should have the authority to run the department within the means of his budget. Vice Chairman Walker noted he agreed with Commissioner Carroll regarding letting the department head run his department.

Sheriff Joyce explained his department's procedures when a vacancy occurs, promoting within if at all possible. Commissioner Lankford stated he had no issues with the Sheriff's procedures of promoting within his department.

Commissioner Carroll stated that the Sheriff also knows his department's needs and has a budget to work with.

Commissioner Smith noted he had no issues with filling any of the requested positions.

The Board had no issues with filling the Social Worker III position.

Chairman Inman, with full consent of the Board, directed the Clerk to place the item on today's Action Agenda.

Request to Declare Surplus Property – Car Cages

Support Services Supervisory Danny Stovall presented the following information regarding the request from the Stokes County Humane Society for five (5) old metal vehicle security screens (car cages):

- Car cages have been removed from patrol vehicles and will not be reused

- Humane Society would like to utilize the items in a Van that is used for transporting animals, having a barrier between the animals prevents animals from being able to jump up in the front of the vehicle
- In the past, discarded cages have been taken to the metal recycling bin at the Landfill
- GS 153A-176 allows the disposition of property by the Board of Commissioners
- GS 160A-266 allows the following methods of sale
 - Private negotiation and sale
 - Advertisement for sealed bids
 - Negotiated offer, advertisement, and upset bid
 - Public Auction
 - Exchange
- GS 160A-267 allows a private sale

The Board discussed possibly allowing a private sale with the cost being possibly \$1.00.

Mr. Stovall discussed the following information regarding a private sale with the Board:

- When the council proposes to dispose of property by private sale, it shall at a regular council meeting adopt a resolution or order authorizing an appropriate official to dispose of the property by private sale at a negotiated price. The resolution or order shall identify the property to be sold and may, but need not, specify a minimum price. A notice summarizing the contents of the resolution or order shall be published once after its adoption, and no sale shall be consummated thereunder until 10 days after its publication.

Chairman Inman, with full consent of the Board, directed Mr. Stovall to proceed with

a private sale, return the needed Resolution for the Board's consideration at the July 27th meeting

Proposed Resolution – Exemption from GS 143-129 – Ambulance Remounts

Support Services Supervisory Danny Stovall presented the following information regarding quotes received from Northwestern Emergency Vehicles for remounting our current ambulance bodies onto new chassis:

- Option #1 \$81,405.00 - 2009 Ford E350 Chassis
- Option #2 \$82,905.00 - 2009 Chevrolet 3500 Chassis
- Option #3 \$82,905.00 - 2009 Ford E450 Chassis
- Option #4 \$84,405.00 - 2009 Chevrolet G4500 Chassis
- Works better placing the small boxes on either the Ford E350 or Chevrolet 3500

EMS Director Monty Stevens noted the following:

- Reiterated the need to remount the boxes on either the Ford E350 or Chevrolet 3500
- Ford will temporarily discontinue production of the series in February 2010 and it will possibly be 18 months before production starts again
- Have had some issues with braking system on the last two E350 purchased
- Feels the 2009 Chevrolet 3500 would be better since Ford could possibly not be making chassis next year
- If the unit that is scheduled for remount is delivered this week, turnaround time is estimated at 60 working days

Mr. Stovall requested to move the item to today's Action Agenda in order to deliver one of units scheduled for remount in hopes of getting ahead of other counties.

Vice Chairman Walker noted the need to try to get the larger boxes if possible.

Commissioner Lankford noted information that he had received had no issues with the Chevrolet Chassis and expressed concerns using the Ford E350 with Ford stopping production next

year.

Commissioners Smith and Carroll preferred the Ford E350 chassis which is approximately \$1500 cheaper.

Mr. Stovall presented the following proposed Resolution that must be adopted in order to proceed with ordering the ambulance remounts.

Resolution

**EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL STATUTE 143-129
FOR FISCAL YEAR 09-10 AMBULANCE/REMOUNT PURCHASES**

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute 143-129 bidding requirement is as follows;

No construction or repair work requiring the estimated expenditure of public money in an amount equal to or more than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) or purchase of apparatus, supplies, materials, or equipment requiring an estimated expenditure of public money in an amount equal to or more than ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) may be performed, nor may any contract be awarded therefor, by any board or governing body of the State, or of any institution of the State government, or of any political subdivision of the State, unless the provisions of this section are complied with;

For purchases of apparatus, supplies, materials, or equipment, the governing body of any political subdivision of the State may, subject to any restriction as to dollar amount, or other conditions that the governing body elects to impose, delegate to the manager, school superintendent, chief purchasing official, or other employee the authority to award contracts, reject bids, or re-advertise to receive bids on behalf of the unit. Any person to whom authority is delegated under this subsection shall comply with the requirements of this Article that would otherwise apply to the governing body.

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute 143-129 contains the following exception;

(e) (6) Exceptions – The requirements of this Article do not apply to:

Purchases of apparatus, supplies, materials, or equipment when: (i) performance or price competition for a product are not available; (ii) a needed product is available from only one source of supply; or (iii) standardization or compatibility is the overriding consideration. Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, the governing board of a political subdivision of the State shall approve the purchases listed in the preceding sentence prior to the award of the contract.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners are convened in a regular meeting:

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF STOKES COUNTY RESOLVES THAT:

Remounting of current ambulance bodies onto new chassis hereby be made exempt from the provisions of North Carolina General Statute bidding requirements per 143-129(e)(6) for the following reasons:

- Northwestern Emergency Vehicles is the only licensed dealer for Horton Emergency Vehicle for the State of North Carolina
- Northwestern Emergency Vehicles is the Horton Emergency Vehicles licensed service provider within the state of North Carolina
- Modules to be remounted were manufactured by Horton Emergency Vehicles and vendor performance is a major consideration

WHEREAS, the Public Health Improvement Plan was proposed with no input from local government officials or local and State public health professionals, and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Association of Local Health Directors has gone on record voicing opposition to this bill, and

WHEREAS, the plan sets out an unreasonable timeline for such reform of the current public health system, and

WHEREAS, the plan calls for no additional public health funding, rather a redistribution of the existing, insufficient funds with no defined distribution formulas, and

WHEREAS, the plan calls for the creation of a Public Health Improvement Plan Task Force which is a duplication of the existing Public Health Task Force, and

WHEREAS, many North Carolina counties are in the process of re-building the Mental Health infrastructure requiring greater contributions of local funds, and

WHEREAS, the same North Carolina counties can ill afford alternation of the public health infrastructure requiring greater local funding to provide core and essential public health services,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that **Stokes County** is opposed to Section 10.26 of Senate Bill 202 or any other budget provision entitled “Public Health Improvement Plan” and stands opposed to any efforts to reform public health absent appropriate planning and significant input from local government officials and local public health professionals.
