BOAT LAUNCH PASSES

Boating season is fast approaching. You may purchase a seasonal launch pass at both Sawyer Boat Launch and Sunset Boat Launch, or stop by our Municipal Services building at 835 N. 14th Ave. between 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

LARGE ITEM COLLECTION

Large item collection takes place the second Friday of the month April through October. This service allows residents to dispose of items that are not able to be picked up with the normal weekly garbage collection. This includes oversized items, metal items and items that require special disposal. If you would like a brush collection that is a separate \$35 fee.

2023 Large Item and Brush Collection Dates:

The cost for this service is \$35 per scheduled collection of non hazardous items. Please see below for the fee schedule for special disposal fees. You may dispose of other hazardous items such as tires and batteries by contacting GFL Environmental (formerly Advanced Disposal) for more information and the cost to properly dispose of these items.

Residents may pick up a form at the Municipal Services building at 835 N. 14th Avenue, Monday through Friday, between 7 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. or by filling out a request form from the City website at www.sturgeonbaywi.org and returning it to our office with payment. **The registration form and payment must be received by our office the prior Wednesday of the desired collection date.** All requests must be made at least 48 hours in advance to ensure your pick up can be properly scheduled.

- Items Containing Freon: \$53.50
- TVs & Monitors up to 27": \$37.50
- TVs 28" - 35": \$48.50
- TVs 36" and larger: \$70.50
- Small Electronics Less than 20 lbs.: \$35.00
- Large Electronics Greater than 20 lbs.: \$43.50

COMPOST SITE INFORMATION

The City operates a compost site that is located at 1531 Division Road. Since grass clippings, garden materials, leaves and brush are not allowed to be placed in landfills, and must be recycled, residents that reside within the City limits may dispose of these items by bringing them to the compost site. If you reside in the township of Sturgeon Bay or Sevastopol you may purchase a permit for the use of the compost site.

Please contact the Municipal Services Department, at 920-746-2912 Monday through Friday between 7:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. to purchase a non resident permit. You may be required to show proof of residency when dropping items off or taking items from the site. The hours of operation are as follows:

The deadline to sign up to participate in the City Wide Garage Sale is Tuesday, May 2nd. No late registrations will be accepted.

The 2023 annual City Wide Garage Sale will take place on Friday, June 2nd and Saturday, June 3rd. Participants will have their choice of hosting their garage sale on just one of the days or both days.

If you reside within the City limits and would like to participate, you may stop by our office (835 N. 14th Avenue) Monday through Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to pick up a registration form to fill out. Provide us with your address, a list of items that you will have at your sale, and the times that you will be "open for business" and leave the rest to us. Forms are also available online at www.sturgeonbaywi.org. Upon registration, an \$8 fee is due to help cover the cost of printing maps. No registrations will be taken by phone or email and the fee must be submitted with the registration form to be placed on the list.

The City will provide a list of locations that are participating in the City Wide Garage Sale and will place each location on a map to make your garage sale easy to find. This information will be available at various locations throughout the City as well as on the City's website, the City's Facebook page and in our office by May 31st.
