Sidewalk Removal at 209 S 10th Ave

BACKGROUND: I was contacted by Paul Sorenson who is the son of the property Owner (Charles Sorenson) at 209 S 10th Ave regarding the sidewalk along the property. The property Owner and his son are requesting to remove the sidewalk. Currently this sidewalk does not tie into any other sidewalks or intersections and over time the grass on both sides of the sidewalk has created berms that just trap water on the sidewalk. In addition, there is not any other North / South sidewalk in the immediate area., I reviewed the sidewalk locations along S 10th Ave between Michigan Street and Texas Street and verified that along that segment of roadway there is only (1) other property with sidewalk which is located right on the corner of Michigan Street and S 10th Ave. The property Owner and his son have offered to remove the sidewalk in question and complete any landscaping / lawn restoration at their own expense with no cost to the City. In addition, the property Owner has agreed to pay a future sidewalk assessment if in the future the City would install new sidewalks along a significant portion of S 10th Ave.

FISCAL IMPACT: None. The property Owner has offered to remove the sidewalk in question and complete any landscaping / lawn restoration at their own expense with no cost to the City. In addition, the property Owner has agreed to pay a future sidewalk assessment if in the future the City would install new sidewalks along a significant portion of S 10th Ave.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the sidewalk removal at 209 S 10th Ave with the requirement that the property Owner is responsible for all removal and restoration expenses, and the property Owner agrees to be assessed for future sidewalks if in the future the City installs new sidewalks along a significant portion of S 10th Ave.
