**A RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING THE POLICY OF THE COMMON
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STURGEON BAY WITH RESPECT TO RESIDENCY AS A
NECESSARY QUALIFICATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO CITY BOARDS & COMMISSIONS**

WHEREAS, it is felt that the minimum qualification for appointment to the boards and commissions of the City of Sturgeon Bay should be that the appointee is a qualified resident of the city, and

WHEREAS, this qualification is not always clearly spelled out in the ordinances and statutes creating such boards and commissions;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Sturgeon Bay that residency in the said city be declared a proper and necessary qualification for an appointee to any of the said boards and commissions of said city, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor be directed to observe such a qualification in making such appointments.
