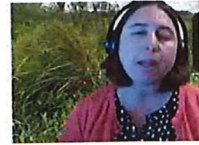

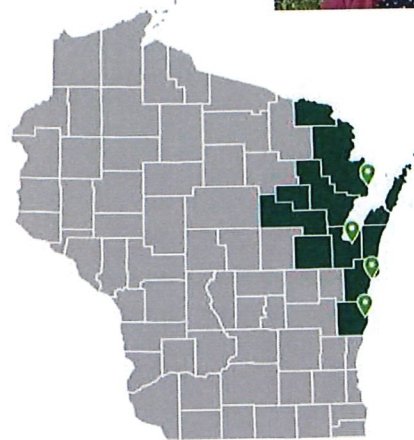

UW-GREEN BAY: A COASTAL UNIVERSITY

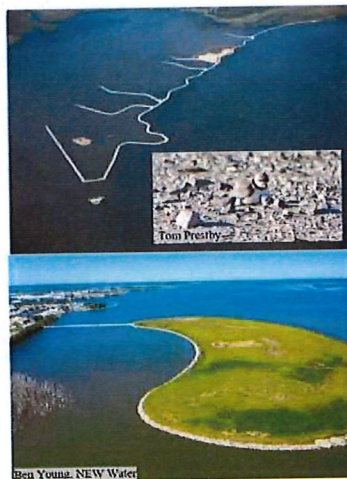


- 4 campus University on 420 miles of Lake Michigan Coastline

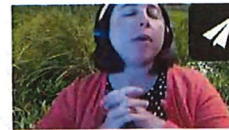
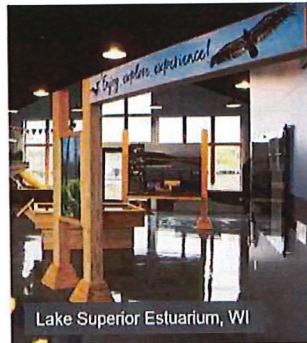

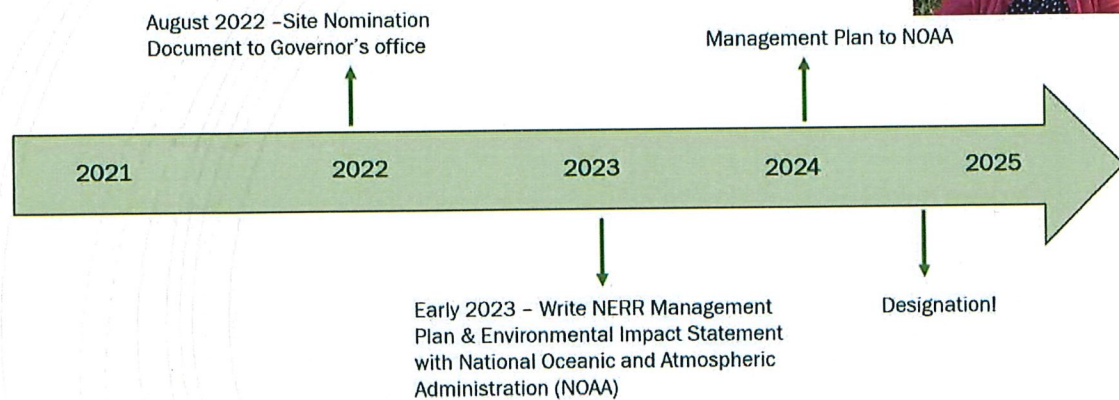
GENERAL SITE STATISTICS

- Designated sites receive ~\$758,000/year for basic operations
- Local funds - an additional minimum ongoing match of 30% (~\$324,800/year)
- Existing facilities range in size: 7,900-28,950 sq ft., avg. 15,176 sq ft.
- Existing reserves range in size from 500 acres (Ohio) – 372,000 acres (Alaska)

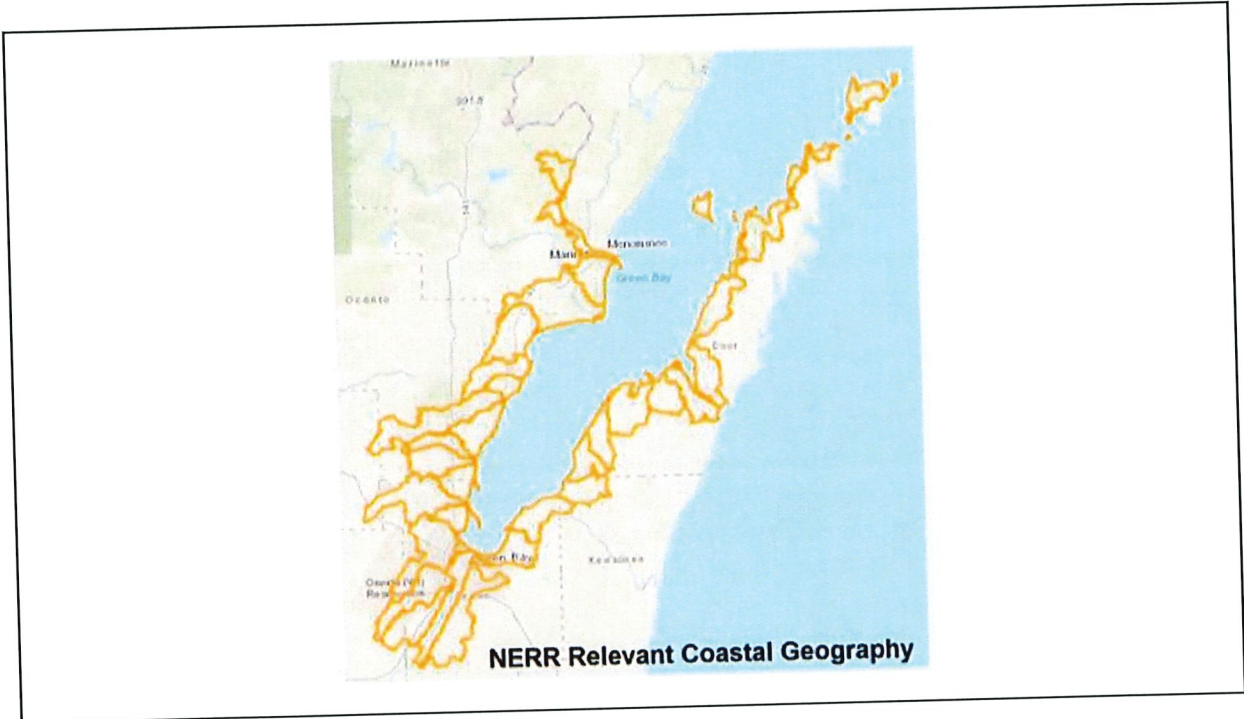

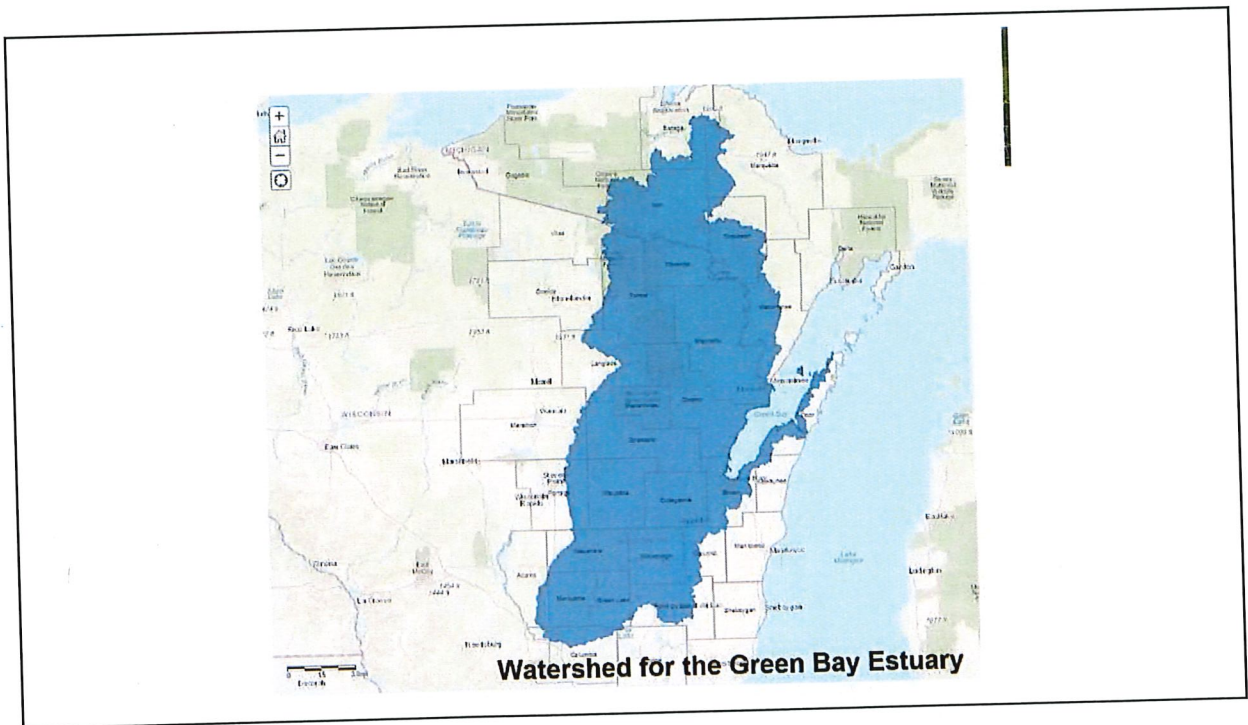
