



The City of Sturgeon Bay's Local Arts Board is excited to introduce *Crosswind Approach*, installed today along the east waterfront promenade in front of Stone Harbor Pub and Restaurant. *Crosswind Approach* is an aluminum sculpture created in 2015 by Door/Brown County artist Steven Haas (Steven Haas Mobiles and Sculptures) and generously on loan to the City from Mr. Haas. *Crosswind Approach*, the artist's vision of a bird landing in a crosswind, faces the Bay as she lands. Artist Haas explained that sometimes a piece tells you what it is going to be as it's created so this work is also known as *Pelican*, the bird many people see when they view her for the first time.

The Local Arts Board extends its thanks to Steven Haas for his generous loan of this stunning sculpture. The piece remains for sale while it is on display by the City. Mr. Haas's mobiles are featured at Margaret Lockwood Gallery in Sturgeon Bay, and his sculptures are featured at Edgewood Orchard Gallery in Fish Creek.
