Mann Communication Contract

The Mann Communication contract was discussed prior in the Cable Communication System Advisory Council and moved for approval by CPS.

Moved by Ald. Reeths, seconded by Ald. Wiederanders, to recommend to the Common Council to approve the Personal Service Contract with Mann Communication, LLC for Cable TV services for the term commencing on January 1, 2021 and ending December 31, 2023 as presented. All ayes.

Downtown Entertainment District – Elimination of Open Intoxicant Ordinance

Captain Brinkman spoke on behalf of the Police Department; he stated they are not opposed to relaxing the ordinance but do need to hear more information (to include: boundaries/zone of the district and days and hours of operation). It was suggested having a trial period as well. Items to also consider: use of plastic or glass containers, increase in garbage/litter and public restroom shortages.

Moved by Ald. Williams, seconded by Ald. Reeths, to table this topic and call a special meeting of the Community Protection and Services Committee prior to the July 21, 2020 Council meeting. All ayes. Carried.

Monarch Butterfly USA Project

Ald. Wiederanders presented information on this program. It is an open commitment which gives access to newsletters and connections to other communities who are in the program. The fee is \$50; Ald. Wiederanders was going to confirm this. This will be brought back to the August meeting for consideration.
