City Engineer Shefchik summarized the request from 209 S. 10th Avenue for sidewalk removal. It was noted that the sidewalks do not tie into any other sidewalks and over time the grass on both sides of the sidewalk has created berms that trap water on the sidewalk. It was also noted that the property owner agrees to pay for removal and restoration of the removed pieces and if there is a sidewalk assessment in the future, they agree to pay that assessment.

Vandertie/Allmann to recommend to the Common Council to approve the sidewalk removal at 209 S. 10th Ave with the requirement that the property owner is responsible for all removal and restoration expenses, and the property owner agrees to be assessed for future sidewalks if in the future the City installs new sidewalks along a significant portion of S. 10th Ave. Carried.
