



Introducing **DOOR COUNTY READY**

Door County Ready is a new County-wide system that will keep you informed and prepared during emergencies. This voluntary program was developed by the Door County Emergency Management Department. The alerts are free, and the system is LIVE now.

Door County Ready will ensure you stay informed and receive timely emergency alerts directly on your mobile device, landline, and/or email. These alerts include:

- Severe weather warnings (tornado, blizzard, extreme heat/cold, etc.).
- Public safety alerts (power outage, wildfire, pandemic, gas leak, etc.).
- Critical situations (cyberattack, national alert issued by the U.S. President or FEMA Administrator).

Door County Ready uses software called [Smart911](#). Sign up is quick and easy and [Smart911](#) is simple to use. You will gain access to real-time updates and official guidance for local authorities to help you stay safe and informed regardless of the emergency.
