**FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS REGARDING
THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 ELECTION**

The City Clerk's Office is fielding many calls about the upcoming November Election. In an effort to disseminate the correct information, please feel free to share this information.

- **When can I vote absentee in person (in the Clerk's Office)?**
 - October 20 – October 30, 2020 from 8 am – 4:30 pm. (On October 29 and October 30, the Clerk's Office will be open until 5 pm.) – 421 Michigan Street, Sturgeon Bay

- **Will a voting machine be set up in your office during in person absentee voting for me to put my ballot in?**
 - No, a machine will not be set up for you to put your ballot in. You will place your ballot in a certified envelope that you sign and your ballot will be processed on Election Day by the Election Workers.

- **Can I hand deliver my absentee ballot back to the Clerk's Office rather than mail it back?**
 - Yes, you can hand deliver your absentee ballot to the City Clerk's Office at 421 Michigan Street during the hours of 8 am – 4:30 pm. After hours, you may place your absentee ballot in the Drop Box located outside of City Hall. The Drop Box will be marked.

- **Can the Clerk's Office witness my absentee ballot envelope for me?**
 - No, the City Clerk's Office CANNOT witness your absentee ballot for you. You will need a witness signature and address on the envelope prior to mailing it back to the Clerk's Office or hand delivering to the Clerk's Office.

- **I am receiving lots of mailings from different groups about requesting an absentee ballot. I already filled out a request for my absentee ballot. Do I have to fill this mailing out again?**
 - If you have already requested an absentee ballot for the November election, you should not fill out another request.

- **Why am I getting all this mail about requesting an absentee ballot?**
 - Different groups and parties are mailing this information to you. The City of Sturgeon Bay HAS NOT and DOES NOT intend to mail you any information about you requesting an absentee ballot. However, we cannot stop these types of mailings from appearing in your mailbox.

- **Do I have to pay postage to mail by absentee ballot back to the City Clerk's Office?**
 - No, you do not. Your return envelope will already have postage on.
