Opportunity to serve in District 2

The current alderman in District 2, Mr. David Hayes, is resigning his position effective September 30 of 2020. This creates a vacancy in District 2 that will be filled by a vote of the City Common Council.

Mayor David Ward outlined the process that will be used to fill the vacancy. The City Clerk will issue an invitation for persons who live in District 2 to apply for the vacancy. Persons interested in filling the seat must be at least 18 years of age and must reside within the District. Those interested in serving should send a brief statement about their background and interest in serving. These statements will be due by October 8. Candidates will then be asked to appear at the October 20 Council meeting and will be given an opportunity to introduce themselves. The Council will then vote on a replacement at that meeting.

Mayor Ward added, "We appreciate the service given by Mr. Hayes and look forward to filling the District 2 seat so that citizens in District 2 are fully represented on the Council."
