Cell-Owl was created in 2017 by Waupaca, WI (formerly of Sturgeon Bay) wood carver Garret Wendlandt of New Leaf Sculpture and Design, LLC. This piece was commissioned by the City of Sturgeon Bay and carved from the remains of an Ash tree that had to be removed from Martin Park at 207 So. Third Avenue.

The cello fits the site perfectly as Martin Park contains the City's bandstand and is home to the summer concert series Harmony by the Bay. Owls are a favorite theme of Mr. Wendlandt's.



Mr. Wendlandt works mainly with wood and is involved in competitions, including the U.S. Open Chainsaw Sculpture Championship. In addition, he has competed in Destination Sturgeon Bay's Fire and Ice Festival in both the ice and snow sculpture competitions.
