



Centennial Capsule

Centennial Capsule. This piece, donated by the Fred Peterson Foundation, is made of aluminum, and fabricated and installed by the employees of the former Peterson Builders of Sturgeon Bay in 1976.

The monument identifies the location of a time capsule buried on that spot in Martin Park, 207 So. Third Avenue, to commemorate the nation's bicentennial year.

The capsule contains artifacts that chronicle the state of the people, businesses, and industry in the City of Sturgeon Bay at that time. The capsule will be unearthed, and its contents and history revealed by the City Administrator in 2076.
