

MINUTES OF THE MEETING  
OF THE  
MOUNT AIRY-SURRY COUNTY AIRPORT AUTHORITY

A meeting of the Mount Airy-Surry County Airport Authority was held at the home of Howard O. Woltz, Jr. at 7:30 P. M. on December 28, 1964, with all members present.

Raymond A. Smith reported on the collection of the private pledges.

A discussion was held evaluating the status of the airport project in view of the adverse Supreme Court decision.

It was agreed that efforts could be made to interest the Smith Reynolds Foundation in supporting the project.

It was also decided to seek Appalachia Funds for the project.

The Chairman, John Banner, reported that the option on the Bob Brown tract would expire on the first day of July and that it could not be renewed without some payment.

The Authority voted to pay \$5,000.00 for an extension of the option on the Brown tract for 18 months provided the payment would apply on the purchase price after the option was exercised.

It was agreed that new contracts should be drawn that would be approved by the FAA and still not violate the Supreme Court decision, if possible.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
