WHAT: Central Texas AirFest

WHEN: Concert and Drone Show: Friday, May 17, from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m.
Air Show: Saturday, May 18, and Sunday, May 19, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

WHERE: Draughon-Miller Central Texas Regional Airport, located at 7720 Airport Road

The City invites the public to experience the thrill of the Central Texas AirFest from May 17 through May 19. The festivities will kick off with a live concert and drone show on Friday night and continue with the aerial show on Saturday and Sunday.

Media Day, which will be held Friday, May 17, ahead of the concert, will give interested media the ability to interview the Airport Director and pilots, record b-roll of the interior and exterior of aircraft parked on the ramp, ride along inside of the B-25 bomber, and obtain b-roll of aircraft doing a quick rehearsal over the airport.

The walkthrough and rehearsal will begin at 12 p.m. and pilots will be available for interviews beginning at 2 p.m.
