### **City of Temple to host three eclipse town halls** *The meetings will be held on February 28, March 2, and March 12*

**TEMPLE, TX (February 21, 2024)** – The City of Temple will host three town halls for residents to learn and ask questions about the total solar eclipse set to happen on Monday, April 8.

**WHAT:** 2024 Eclipse Town Halls

**WHEN:** Wednesday, February 28 at 10 a.m., Saturday, March 2 at 2 p.m., and Tuesday, March 12 at 6 p.m.

**WHERE:** Sammons Community Center Lakeview Room, Grace Temple Ministries, and Mayborn Community Center

Central Texas is expected to be in the path of totality for the total solar eclipse happening on April 8, and the City of Temple invites the community to attend a town hall and learn more about what can be expected from this spectacular event.

The first town hall will be held on February 28 at Sammons Community Center, the second on March 2 at Grace Temple Ministries, and the third on March 12 at the Mayborn Community Center. Residents can attend one of these public meetings to hear from Temple's Emergency Management Coordinator about what the eclipse is, how to view it, and how to prepare. Residents will also have the opportunity to ask questions as well.

As Temple is listed as one of the best places in the United States to experience the eclipse, the City could see an increase in population for several days before and after the event. Factors of a potential influx could include things like traffic congestion and heavy cell usage. The City's Emergency Management Coordinator and representatives from both Temple Fire and Rescue and the Temple Police Department will be available to answer questions regarding this aspect of the eclipse as well.
