Rainfall causes sewer overflow

TEMPLE, TX (April 10, 2024) – The City of Temple is providing public notification of two significant sewer overflows.

Due to rainfall overloading the sewer system, on Tuesday, April 9, a sanitary sewer overflow occurred at 3420 Northwood Road and at 50th and West Adams.

It is estimated the Northwood overflow consisted of over 402,100 gallons. The 50th and West Adams overflow consisted of over 489,500 gallons.

City of Temple utility crews are working to rectify and disinfect the overflows.

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has been notified.
