Temple Police Department arrests two juveniles at Temple High School

TEMPLE, TX (August 30, 2023) – The Temple Police Department has arrested two 15-year-old male juveniles after reports of a student armed with a handgun at Temple High School (THS).

At around 7:45 a.m. on Wednesday, August 30 a student reported to a School Resource Officer (SRO) that he thought another student had a weapon in his backpack. The campus was put on a secure hold and additional Temple PD officers responded to THS. Officers located the student who was in possession of a handgun. The student was immediately taken into custody. A second student was also detained and searched for a weapon. During the detainment, the student became assaultive towards an officer and was taken into custody. At approximately 8:59 a.m. the campus secure hold was released.

One suspect was arrested for possession of a handgun. The second suspect was arrested for assault on a public servant. Both have been taken to the Bell County Juvenile Detention Center in Killeen.

THS has resumed all normal operations.
