Temple Police Department investigates an aggravated assault, 4 injured

TEMPLE, TX (October 1, 2024) – The Temple Police Department's initial investigation reveals an assault occurred at the 9300 block of Highway 317. The victim then fled in a vehicle and was chased by the suspect south down Highway 317 where the victim's vehicle was pushed into oncoming traffic by the suspect's vehicle causing the T-bone collision to occur at the 7500 block of Highway 317. This collision damaged three vehicles.

Four individuals were transported to the hospital. Three remain in stable condition and one remains in critical condition. At this time no one has been arrested, and there is one suspect who fled from the scene.

TEMPLE, TX (October 1, 2024) – The Temple Police Department is investigating an aggravated assault that injured four people.

At around 8:16 p.m. on Monday, September 30, officers were dispatched to the 7500 block of North Highway 317 for a traffic accident. Upon arrival, officers found one vehicle had t-boned another vehicle. The initial investigation reveals an assault occurred at the 9300 block of South Highway 317 and then one individual chased another individual south down Highway 317 causing the collision.

Three individuals have been transported to the hospital with major injuries, and one has been transported with life-threatening injuries.

The Temple Police Department Criminal Investigations Unit is on scene investigating this incident.
