Temple Police Department investigates injury to a child

TEMPLE, TX (November 1, 2024) – The Temple Police Department and Department of Family and Protective Services have through investigation determined that the owner of Ignite Learning Academy, 32-year-old Taylor Beck from Temple, TX, will be charged with failure to report a felony. A warrant was issued for her arrest on Thursday, October 31, and at 11:58 a.m. on Friday, November 1, Taylor Beck turned herself in to Bell County Jail.

TEMPLE, TX (October 24, 2024) – The Temple Police Department is investigating an injury to a child.

At around 11:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 16, officers were dispatched to the Baylor Scott and White McLane Children's Specialty Clinic for a welfare concern regarding a three-month old child. Upon arrival, officers learned the child had been taken to Ignite Learning Academy in Temple, TX for daycare around 8:00 a.m. that morning. At around 4:00 p.m., the child began showing unusual lethargy. EMS was contacted, and it was decided to transport the child for medical care.

The Temple Police Department and Child Protective Services are working closely on this case. At this time, 24-year-old Jasmine Collum, who was a teacher at Ignite Learning Academy, has been arrested for injury to a child.

This case is currently under investigation.
