Temple Police Department investigates multiple shootings

TEMPLE, TX (June 6, 2024) – The Temple Police Department is investigating a series of shootings.

At around 12:00 a.m. officers were dispatched to the 100 block of S 22nd Street for a report of shots fired. Officers located shell casings and subsequent property damage to a vehicle and an occupied home, but no injuries. At around 4:18 a.m. officers were notified of shots fired at the 1700 block of E Adams. Upon arrival, officers located shell casings in the roadway, property damage to an occupied home, and no injuries. At around 5:15 a.m. officers responded to a call for shots fired. Officers found shell casings in the roadway, no damage, and no injuries. At around 9:30 a.m. officers responded to a call at the 600 block of N 8th Street. Upon arrival, officers were informed by the homeowner at an unknown time last night shots were fired into their home. No injuries were reported.

The preliminary investigation from the Temple Police Department Criminal Investigations Division shows a small-sized black SUV having been stolen from the Village at Meadowbend and spotted by a witness at one of the calls for shots fired.
