City Services and Facilities Updates - Inclement Weather *Delayed Opening*

TEMPLE, TX (February 1, 2023) – Due to freezing temperatures expected through Thursday morning, all City of Temple facilities will open at 1 p.m. on Thursday, February 2.

Emergency services will continue to operate as normal.

Garbage collections will resume on Friday, February 3. All garbage bins should be placed at the curb Friday morning by 7 a.m. Garbage will be collected all day Friday, Saturday and Monday. Recycling collections will resume on Tuesday. Visit templetx.gov/solidwaste for additional collection updates/schedules.

Utility crews are responding to water & sewer emergencies. To report a water leak or outage, call 254-217-4153.

The Public Works Department continues to sand the most-traveled and priority sections of City-maintained roads and bridges. For fallen trees in the roadways residents may call 254-298-5653.

Two warming shelters are currently operating in Temple. Salvation Army, located at 419 W. Avenue G, and Impact Church, located at 306 E. Adams Ave. Please contact each facility for information regarding their shelters.

To report a power outage, visit Oncor's Storm Center website, stormcenter.oncor.com, call 888-313-4747 or text OUT to 66267. Registration for "My Oncor Alerts" is required. To register for My Oncor Alerts, text REG to 66267.

For gas emergencies and leaks, call 911. Then, call Atmos Gas' emergency line at 866-322-8667.

Additional City staff, including Police and Fire Department personnel, are on-call to respond if call volumes increase due to the winter storm impact.
