City of Temple to host UDC Update Kickoff Public Meeting

TEMPLE, TX (March 28, 2023) – The City of Temple will host a public meeting to kick off the Temple Unified Development Code (UDC) Update with White & Smith Law Firm and Half Associates.

The City of Temple seeks to update and revamp the City's Unified Development Code (UDC) to bring it into alignment with requirements from the Temple 2020 Comprehensive Plan, which recognizes the current growth of the community and describes how the City will approach future growth, goals, and policies.

The goals included in the public meeting are:

- Modernizing and creating user-friendly processes and procedures for development
- Targeting portions of the UDC that are problematic or outdated
- Establishing efficient and flexible review and approval procedures throughout the UDC, to include clear cross-references between the UDC and relevant City Ordinances
- Creating development standards that facilitate and encourage redevelopment and business reinvestment within existing commercial corridors and stimulate infill development
- Creating procedures that would allow alternative compliance to development standards to accommodate site context
- Implementing strategic planning documents, including the 2020 Comp Plan and other Master Plans.
- Ensuring the code follows any State or Federal law changes
