### **Temple Police Department identifies deceased in auto vs pedestrian**

**TEMPLE, TX (August 28, 2023)** – The Temple Police Department is investigating an auto vs pedestrian accident that left one male deceased.

At around 8:28 a.m. on August 25, officers were dispatched to the southbound lanes of Interstate 35 near exit 304 for an auto vs pedestrian accident. During the course of the investigation, officers discovered the male was attempting to cross I-35 on foot heading westbound. The male successfully crossed northbound traffic but was struck by a vehicle as he was attempting to cross southbound traffic.

There were no signs of foul play and Justice of the Peace Larry Wilkey pronounced the male deceased.

The male has been identified as 28-year-old Kenneth Hyland of Georgetown.
