



# HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE PUBLIC NOTICE

## BACKGROUND

In coordination with the Central Texas Council of Governments, Bell County and the following jurisdictions: Cities of Bartlett, Belton, Harker Heights, Holland, Killeen, Little River Academy, Morgan’s Point Resort, Nolanville, Rogers, Temple and Troy, and the Village of Salado are updating the Hazard Mitigation Plan. The Plan Update will address natural hazards that affect the area. The goal of the Plan Update is to minimize or eliminate the long-term risk to human life and property from known hazards through effective mitigation.

Bell County will hold a public meeting to gather public input for updating their Hazard Mitigation Plan. The purpose of the public meeting is to provide a project overview from H2O Partners, Inc., consultant to the project, and solicit information from citizens. Public input will help the project team to analyze potential hazards affecting residents and recommend possible actions to reduce their impact.
