TPD investigates shooting incident that resulted in property damage and one injury

TEMPLE, TX (June 5, 2023)– At 1:31 a.m. Temple police officers were dispatched to the 400 block of S. 32nd St. in response to a shots fired call.

Upon arrival, officers found damage to two residences and one vehicle from being shot. They did not locate a victim at that scene.

Shortly after, a call was dispatched to the 1200 block of S. 26th St., where a male victim was identified with non-life-threatening injuries and is being treated at BS&W.

No suspect has been identified at this time. TPD is currently investigating to identify if both incidents are related.
