Moore's Mill Road Closures

Construction to begin Monday, February 12, 2024

TEMPLE, TX (February 6, 2024) – As the City of Temple works on phase three of the North Outer Loop project, construction is set to begin on Monday, February 12. Throughout this phase of construction, Moore's Mill Road will experience various closures.

Moore's Mill Road, from Wendland Road to Brewster Road, will remain open while the southern, eastbound lanes are under construction. The portion of Moore's Mill Road, starting on the east side of Brewster Road to the east side of the BNSF railroad crossing, will be closed due to bridge construction. The remainder of Moore's Mill Road from the east side of the BNSF railroad crossing to Pegasus Drive will remain open for resident access but not through traffic.

Construction is approximated to last until October 2025.

The Outer Loop Project will connect Interstate 35 in North and South Temple and improve mobility on the West Side. The main project is broken up into North and West projects and will create a four-lane road with a raised median, bike lanes, and pedestrian trails. This phase of the North project will widen and realign Moore's Mill Road from a two-lane rural road to a four-lane divided arterial with shared-use paths and drainage improvements to include an elevated bridge structure at the BNSF railroad crossing.
