Barnhardt Road Closure

Phase 2 construction and closures set to begin on May 6

TEMPLE, TX (April 29, 2024) – UPDATE: Phase 2 of the Barnhardt Road Reconstruction Project will begin on Monday, May 6. The previous Phase 1 road closures will be expanded to include Barnhardt Road and a portion of Little River Road.

Little River Road will be closed to through traffic from Blackland Road to Cedar River Lane. Traffic will be diverted through the Prairie Ridge Subdivision along Thunder Basin Drive and Cedar River Lane. A three-way stop condition is proposed for the intersection of Blackland Road and Thunder Basin Drive.

Phase 2 construction is estimated to last through August 2024.

TEMPLE, TX (February 26, 2024) – As the City of Temple begins Phase 1 of the Barnhardt Road Reconstruction Project, construction crews will be closing Barnhardt Road to through traffic on Monday, March 4.

Phase 1 detours will be available via SH 95 and Little River Road, and the closure is anticipated to remain in place through mid-January 2025.

The Barnhardt Road Reconstruction Project features roadway expansions, curb and gutter, underground storm sewer, pedestrian facilities, landscaping, striping and signage, and an extension of the City's water distribution system.
