

ITEM DESCRIPTION: Consider adopting a resolution canvassing the returns of the May 8, 2010 City of Temple general election for City Councilmember District 4.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Adopt resolution as presented in item description.

ITEM SUMMARY: The terms of the District 1 Councilmember Tony Jeter and District 4 Councilmember Russell Schneider expire May 2010. Councilmember Jeter did not file for re-election and only one candidate did file in District 1, Danny Dunn, and he was declared elected by the City Council on April 1, 2010. Two candidates filed for the District 4 Councilmember position – incumbent Russell Schneider and Justice Bigbie.

The election was held on May 8, 2010. The official tabulation is an attachment to this item.

The proposed resolution will adopt the official returns of the May 8, 2010 election and declare Russell Schneider elected to the position of Councilmember District 4 in the City of Temple for a three year term.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS OF THE MAY 8, 2010, CITY COUNCIL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THE DISTRICT 4 CITY COUNCILMEMBERS; DECLARING THE RESULTS THEREOF AND ORDERING A RUNOFF ELECTION IF NECESSARY; TABULATING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF VOTES; DECLARING FINDINGS OF FACT; AND PROVIDING AN OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE.

Whereas, on the 8th day of May, 2010, the City of Temple, Texas, held its regular City Council election for the purpose of electing the District 4 City Councilmember;

Whereas, it appears from the returns of said election, that of the 10,914 registered voters in District 4, 460 cast valid and legal votes for the Councilmember position;

Whereas, it appears that each of the candidates in said Temple City Council election received the following votes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPLE, TEXAS:

Part 1: On the 14th day of May, 2010, the City Council of the City of Temple, Texas, convened in a special meeting, duly advertised and open to the public, at its regular meeting place with a quorum present, for the purpose of canvassing the returns of the above called election, and, said election being duly called, notice thereof being given in accordance with the law and said election being held in accordance with the law, it appears, and the same is hereby ordered, that

Russell T. Schneider *for COUNCIL DISTRICT #4* *3 YEAR TERM*

were elected at said election, and are hereby declared duly elected subject to the taking of the oaths as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.
