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### Announcements

Cory Tobin called the meeting to order. Cory asked for a motion to approve the agenda for today's meeting. The motion was approved by Keith Tobin and seconded by Fred Bookman. The motion was carried unanimously. There was no one who signed up for the Public Forum.

### Agenda Items

- a. **Fee Schedule Updates** – Fee adjustments can help our revenue intake and the fee schedule has not been changed in a while. Last year we had a rate increase for April 1<sup>st</sup> before the new budget. We made a few changes to the fee schedule to potentially get more revenue. We wanted to generate a little more money but we did not want to overcharge those individuals who are regular golfers. We do expect to see a large influx on the western side of the county because Lexington is getting work done to their golf course.
- b. **On Course Bathrooms** – We met on site with Adam Litwin and hope to start the building at the beginning of February. The building will face the 16 path with access to the 3<sup>rd</sup> tee box. The restroom building will require solar energy because our septic system will need a pump and it will come all the way across our 3<sup>rd</sup> fairway into the wooded area. This solar power panel will be on top of the roof and will help operate the pump.
