Announcements

Don Clinard called the meeting to order. Don asked for a motion to approve the agenda for today's meeting. There was a motion by Fred Bookman and seconded by Bradley White, the motion carried unanimously. There was no one who signed up for the Public Forum.

Agenda Items

- a. **ARPA Projects** – Allen updated everyone that the building construction for the driving range would begin in the next few weeks. The Septic permit application was been submitted to the county Health Department. These two items are major projects for the course. Once the building is constructed, the bays will be used for simulator play and instruction. The challenge will be creating a schedule for the use and staffing the facility.
- b. **Marketing** – Cory reported that a new marketing campaign has started with the Thomasville Tourism Commission. The Tourism department created a Billboard slide that will run on the electronic billboard above Sunrise Grille. The ad encourages play and will run consistently during the warmer season. There is also a meeting scheduled with Golfnow to review our current website and online processing. Golfnow has switched to a new platform "G1" and this could update the aesthetics of our current page and older model.
- c. **Maintenance Projects** – Allen reported that work continues on the short game area. He has identified areas of disrepair on some of the cart paths that will need attention at the turn of the new fiscal year. These areas specifically will be between the 8th and 9th hole. Grass is beginning to pop and it seems that most of the areas



will start in earnest soon. He did have concern of winterkill potentially on the 2nd hole white tee box. The Staff have been working to spruce up around the clubhouse with mulch and will continue this in other bed areas. Golf cart batteries are a concern currently with some not operating for the appropriate amount of time.

- d. **Greens Reports-** Greens were plugged the middle of March and are recovering nicely. The play has not been impacted and it continues to improve. This is a bi-annual maintenance need that the course continues throughout the years.
