

Sec. 34-210. Same-Driveways.

All driveway openings in curbs shall be as specified by the county road commission or the department of state highways when these are contiguous to an arterial street or state highway.

Sec. 34-211. Same-Storm drainage.

(a) An adequate storm drainage system must be designed by a Professional Engineer in the State of Michigan, including necessary storm sewers, drain inlets, manholes, culverts, bridges, detention /retention basins, rearlot / perimeter drains and other appurtenances, shall be required in all developments (plat, condominium, or multi split parcels). The design, operational, and maintenance requirements for each development shall be established by the county drain commissioner and the township board. Any required detention/retention basin as a part of the drainage system shall become the responsibility of the deeded owners of the developments to operate and maintain.

(b) Construction shall follow the specifications and procedures established by the county drain commissioner. All proposed storm drainage construction plans for proposed plats shall be approved by the county drain commissioner.
