

**National Prescription Drug Take Back Day
October 23, 2021**



National Prescription Drug Take Back Day is a safe, convenient, and responsible way to dispose of unused or expired prescription drugs at locations in communities throughout the country.

The April 2021 National Take Back Day brought in 839,543 lbs. (420 Tons) of unused prescription medications.¹ Unfortunately, the past 2 years has created many challenges to our community partners and citizens due to COVID-19, and there is limited participation locally within Trempealeau County for the upcoming prescription take back event.

We want to make you aware there are alternate options available to our residents and community members.
