## LOCKED DOORS

## NO ONE AT HOME

## AFTER BUSINESS HOURS

Are just a few of the problems that the Dexter Area Fire Department have encountered when responding to MEDICAL EMERGENCIES and FIRE ALARMS.

- Have you ever thought what would happen if *I was at home and could not get to the door to let in the Fire Department?*
- What would happen if *my fire alarm goes off and I am not at home?*
- Do you know of an elderly person that lives alone?

The answer to these questions is simple a **KNOX BOX**.

- **WHAT IS A KNOX BOX?** A Knox Box is a secure entry system that only the Dexter Area Fire Department can open in the event of an emergency.
- **HERE IS HOW IT WORKS,** Call the Dexter Area Fire Department Fire Marshalls Division and request a Knox Box Company form. Send the completed form to the Knox Company. Your Knox Box will arrive unlocked. All you have to do is call the Dexter Area Fire Department to confirm the location of the Knox Box. When your Knox Box is installed the Dexter Area Fire Department will come to your home and place the needed keys into the Knox Box.

**\*\*ALL KNOX BOXES MUST BE PLACED ON THE DOOR OR OUTSIDE WALL  
FACING THE ROAD OR STREET SIDE OF THE BUILDING\*\***
