MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen by birth or naturalization;
- Be at least 18 years of age and not more than 44 years of age at the time of hire; if the applicant is between 18 and 20 years of age, he or she must have received an associate degree or have 60 semesters hours' credit from an accredited college or university;
- Be a graduate of an accredited high school or have an equivalency certificate;
- A Texas Driver License;
- Be able to read, write, and speak the English language

REQUIREMENTS at the time of hire:

- Valid Peace Officers Certification;
- Compliance for current/future licensing by the Texas Communications on Law Enforcement (TCOLE);
- Achieve a minimum passing score of seventy (70) percent on the written examination;
- Successfully complete the physical agility test;
- Pass a background investigation;
- Pass oral interviews;
- Successfully complete a post-job offer psychological examination and medical examination that includes passing a visual acuity test, and physician certification that the applicant is not dependent on and does not use illegal drugs;
- Be of good moral character

Military Discharge Papers (DD-214 form) which shows: (1) showing a minimum of 180 total days of active military service, and (2) an honorable discharge, in order to receive five (5) points in addition to his passing score on the written examination. General discharges under honorable conditions or any other discharges are ineligible to receive military points.

Candidates are required to attach clean, clear copies of the following documents; otherwise, applications shall be considered incomplete and not eligible to test. Unless otherwise prohibited by law document(s) must be presented at time of exam.

- Valid Texas Driver's license;
- Birth certificate;
- Social security card;
- High School Diploma, official transcript, or Equivalency Certificate (G.E.D.) certified by the issuing Agency (TEA). **College diplomas or transcripts will not substitute as part of High School Diploma, Official Transcript or G.E.D**
- College Transcript, if applicable
