2. Chief Zimm asked the group to be aware of the dispatch plans that are coming out from the County this week.
3. Chief Zimm announced that the County through an advisory notice that the County dispatch will move forward to high-band 700MHz for communications and stay in 150MHz for dispatch. The County is asking that each municipality submit a count of total radios owned.
4. Chief Bilger talked about service complaints as to the vendors of the hose testing and asked how to file a complaint. The point of this is to avoid using the same company in the future. He also asked how service of EPI is administered and stated problems with repaired trucks.
