JOINT MEETING MINUTES

1. A. The Special January 17, 2019 West Deptford Township Committee and West Deptford Township School Board Meeting was called to order by Lee Ann DeHart, RMC.

C. Marty Gray Field – Township – The current usage was discussed as was the Lacrosse field at RiverWinds. A follow up with the Township Engineer will be scheduled to review drainage.

D. Grade Level Configurations – Board – The WDTSB will continue to meet and discuss.

E. Sidewalks – Board – Potential sidewalks on Hessian Avenue and Jessup Road were discussed, WDTSB will give the Township the exact areas and a follow up with the Engineer will be scheduled.

F. Other – Traffic Light at Friars Boulevard was discussed and it will be looked into.

Other Shared Services were discussed, Custodial, Plumbing, Electrical, HVAC. It was noted that the two groups should meet maybe once per year.

5. OPEN MEETING TO THE PUBLIC - Deputy Mayor Mehaffey motioned to open the meeting to the public, Mr. Reid seconded his motion and was approved by the entire Committee.
