

RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT APPLICATION FOR AND APPROPRIATION OF REVENUE SHARING GRANT FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ROUTE 10 AND TURNER DRIVE IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to submit an application for an allocation of Revenue Sharing funds of up to, but not to exceed, \$5,000,000 for the construction of Route 10 (Benns Church Blvd) and Turner Drive (Rt 644) Improvements, to include dual westbound left turn lanes, a single lane roundabout, and related ancillary signal, pedestrian, and utility improvements; and,


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is committed to providing up to \$10,000,000 in project front-funding, with a total local match contribution not to exceed \$5,000,000 for the construction of Route 10 (Benns Church Blvd) and Turner Drive (Rt 644) Improvements; and,

WHEREAS, Isle of Wight County is committed to public safety and economic development benefits that this project will provide for the community and is partnering with local public and private stakeholders to bring this improvement to the corridor; and,


WHEREAS, Isle of Wight County has the staff resources and expertise, including the required State certifications and training, to locally administer this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Isle of Wight County, Virginia, that the County hereby supports and makes application for this project under the Virginia Department of Transportation Revenue Sharing Program.


