NIKE PARK





7410 Fort Boykin Trail, Isle of Wight, VA 23430 Fort Boykin has been a part of American history since 1623 when a fort known as the Castle was constructed following the 1622 Indian Attack. Today, Fort Boykin constitutes an example of military architecture of the Civil War era. Join us for this free walking tour through history.
