SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING



What is Single-Stream Recycling?

Single-Stream Recycling is the process in which all acceptable materials are collected all *mixed together* with no sorting required by individual recyclers.

What Are the Potential Advantages To Single-Stream Collection?

- **Single-Stream** makes collection easy and convenient for residents, which means increased participation and more material diverted from the landfill.
- **Single-Stream** reduces collection cost by decreasing the number of trips made to the Refuse & Recycling Center.
- **Single-Stream** allows for more paper grades; such as junk mail, telephone books and mixed residential paper.

Did you Know?

- **Pizza Boxes** - Only the Clean part of the box can be recycled.
- **Styrofoam products** - are not accepted for recycling.
- Recycling conserves natural resources, saves energy, reduces pollution, creates jobs, and saves money.

Recycle It Together



Residents can bring all recyclable materials to a Refuse & Recycling Center located throughout the County. Residents no longer have to sort their recyclable materials. All recyclable items can be placed in the same container for easy collection.

Please place all acceptable materials into the **“GREEN”** Recycling Containers located at all the County Refuse & Recycling Centers.

Separate collection containers are provided for:

Plastic Bags
Electronic Equipment
Scrap Metal
Appliance
Motor Oil
Cooking Oil

Yard Waste (*leaves, sticks, and limbs 6” in diameter and no longer than 6’ in length.*)



What can be recycled?

Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs, etc.



Cardboard

(please break down boxes)

Paperboard (cereal, tissue, shoe boxes, etc.)

Telephone & Soft Cover Books



Junk Mail & Envelopes
(all types)

Paper (all colors-no rubber bands, paper clips or plastic wrap.)



Food Containers (cottage cheese, margarine, etc.)

Plastic Bottles (marked #1-#7)



Soda, Juice & Water Bottles
(glass or plastic)

Aluminum (pie plates, trays, foil, etc.)



Glass Bottles & Jars (any color)

Milk Jugs, Bleach, Detergent & Shampoo Bottles



Metal Cans (tin, steel, aluminum)



Please rinse drink & food containers
