



**AGREEMENT IN LIEU OF AN EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL
PLAN FOR A SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENCE**

In lieu of submission of an erosion and sediment control plan for the construction of this single family dwelling, I agree to comply with any reasonable requirements determined necessary by employees of Isle of Wight County, representing the Erosion and Sediment (E&S) Control Program Administrator. Such requirements shall be based on the conservation standards contained in the Isle of Wight County Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance, E&S measures contained in the *Virginia Erosion and Sediment Control Handbook* and shall represent the minimum practices necessary to provide adequate control of erosion and sedimentation on or resulting from this project.

***Any necessary perimeter sediment trapping measures will be installed prior to land disturbance and all denuded areas on the lot shall be stabilized within seven days of final grading with permanent vegetation or a protective ground cover suitable for the time of year. Please note that a C.O. may be denied if the site is not permanently stabilized.**

***All vehicular access to the site shall be limited to 12-foot by 70-foot construction entrance, stabilized with VDOT #1 stone at least 6 inches thick, with a minimum of 3 inches of stone placed in a cut section to give the entrance added stability and to help secure the filter cloth separator. Based upon specific site conditions, the E&S Administrator may approve a 12-foot-by 30-foot mulch construction entrance (a minimum of 6 inches thick, no filter cloth) for UR, PD-R, PD-MH, PD-MX, SR, NC, and SE zonings.**

I further understand that failure to comply with requirements within three working days following notice by the representatives of Isle of Wight County could result in citation for violation of the Isle of Wight County Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance.

Responsible Land Disturber (RLD) Certification

Isle of Wight County is required to ensure that the person responsible for carrying out the land disturbing plan (site plan) provides the name of an individual holding a certificate of competence who will be in charge of and responsible for carrying out the land- disturbing activity. The Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) issues the Responsible Land Disturber Certification. Individuals certified by DCR as an Inspector, Plan Reviewer, Program Administrator or Combined Administrator, and individuals licensed in Virginia as a Professional Engineer, Land Surveyor, Landscape Architect or Architect, are also qualified.
