

**Electoral Board
Isle of Wight County Virginia
4-9 November 2020**

The Electoral Board of Isle of Wight County held a scheduled meeting 4 November 2020 at the General Registrars Office at IOW Courthouse to canvas the Presidential Election held 3 November 2020. The Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:05 AM. Present were Inetha Holmes, Chairman, Regina Haggerty, Vice Chairman, William Bell, Secretary, Lisa Betterton, Director of Elections (DE). Michael Kemp, IOW Republican Party Chair was in attendance. Deborah Church, IOW Democratic Party Chair joined about 30 minutes later.

The first order of business was to act on the provisional ballots. There were 114 Provisional ballots submitted. Redacted copies of the Provisional Ballot Log were made for interested parties.. A copy of the Provisional Ballot Log was given to Ms Mainwaring, Deputy Registrar, for research. It was decided to cast provisional ballots after research had been completed and the CAP precinct had been closed on Friday at noon.

The canvas of the results then began.

The canvass was completed at 2:30 PM. An error in recording the called in figures occurred in the Smithfield precinct. It was corrected and had no impact on the outcome of the race. Several errors occurred in reporting write ins for President. Tape showed all write ins but only valid per ELECT provided guidance were to be reported. Corrected. No impact.

The board voted to recess the canvass at 2:30 PM and reconvene at 12 noon on Friday 6 November 2020.

The board reconvened at 12 noon on Friday 6 November.

Ms Mainwaring provided information on provisional ballot issues not related to Absentee mail in voting. The board then reviewed remaining ballots against the CAP Poll Book and opened the Provisional precinct, completed a poll book and cast 102 ballots. 99 were fed into a DS 200 and 3 were hand counted.

The board voted to recess the canvass at 4:30 PM and reconvene at 9 AM on Monday 9 November 2020.

The board reconvened at 9 AM on Monday 9 November

The abstract was prepared, signed and given to the DE for distribution.

The board decided to that if drop boxes at precincts are to become standard that procedures for collection need to be revisited.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 11:15.
