What We're Expecting

Timing: This afternoon (mainly after 1 PM) through this evening.

Potential Impacts: Brief tornadoes, damaging wind gusts, very heavy rainfall. **Highest risk for tornadoes NE NC, SE VA, and South Central VA.**

A variety of weather hazards are possible through tonight, remain weather aware today.
