

Tuesday, January 16, 2018 – 9:00 am

As of this morning's National Weather Service (NWS) forecast, Isle of Wight has a 70-80% chance of seeing snow on Weds. The NWS is forecasting 1-3" of snow for the area – most likely somewhere in the 1-2" range in the county. NWS is forecasting a slight chance that snow could begin as early as 4am, snow chances will continue to rise until about 10am when snow is likely across the county. The forecast has the snow chances beginning to taper off around 4pm and the snow should be over by around 8pm. Low temperatures tonight will be near freezing and stay there until around 10am when the temps. will begin to fall into the high 20s. Ice is not forecast to be an issue with this system for IOW.

Roadway conditions will likely be impacted once the snow begins. Roads are expected to become snow covered and hazardous travel conditions are possible for both the morning and evening commutes on Weds. Encourage everyone to use caution tomorrow if driving. Allow extra distance between you and the vehicle ahead of you, and use slow, steady pressure when breaking.
